


The real deal

- OThree quarters of youth with sexual behavior problems meet criteria for at least one mental disorder.
- OComorbidity found in more than half
- OAlmost two-thirds were functionally impaired

Different groups

- O Child Victim
 - Internalizing problems
 - O Affective or anxiety issues
 - Greater likelihood of victimization
 - O Poor social skills
 - O ADHD
 - Spectrum Disorders
- O Non-Child Victims
- Externalizing problems
- Conduct disorder & ODDSubstance use and abuse
- Less comorbidity
