

Course Objectives: This course is intended to provide an overview of abnormal psychology for advanced undergraduate students. *Introductory Psychology*, PSY 101, is a prerequisite for taking this course. By means of e-modules, quizzes, case studies, reflective journaling, and associated readings, an introduction to the major diagnostic categories of the DSM-5 including theories of causation and various therapeutic interventions is planned.

Class Format: Although this is an online class, I encourage you to use the virtual office hours for any questions you might have about anything: the course, how to apply to graduate school, asking about differences in degrees and grad schools, etc.! I look forward to getting to know you through your bi-weekly journaling. I will write you back to share ideas and insights!

Upon successful completion of this course, students will be able to:

- 1. Describe the current system of classifying psychological disorders.
- 2. Decide when you or someone you know may need evaluation by a professional by using the diagnostic criteria of specific psychological disorders.
- 3. Identify and explain the biological, psychological, social, and cognitive factors underlying etiology and maintenance of selected psychological disorders.
- 4. Explain major theoretical models and their contribution to the understanding of psychological disorders.
- 5. Explain how the research process and research findings influence the conceptualization and treatment of psychological disorders.

Grading: Your final grade will be based on: 34 quizzes, 18 case studies, 13 Mastery Training modules, 8 profiles, and 5 reflection and question journal entries.

Thus, the maximum number of points you can gain for all: is 951 points.

Through this graded bi-weekly (roughly) journal activity it is my goal to encourage you to reflect on new knowledge learned in class, solidify your learning experience by recording your evolving thought process as you progress further in the course, learn new material, and form new conclusions. It can also encourage you to formulate new opinions and perspectives, and gives you a risk-free venue to explore, think, and practice skills learned in class. Students who write regularly in a journal consistently see improvements in their writing skills, as well as their creative and reflective thinking (Stevens & Cooper, 2009, p. 15-16, 33 as cited Van Walraven, 2017).

You will only be evaluated on content, not form, spelling, or grammar. *Except on holidays.
