Major Notes

- 1) One internship is required. However, students may take up to 6 credits of OSH 490 as (1) 6-hour internship or (2) 3-hour internships.
- 2) It is encouraged to use free electives to fulfill course work for a minor. Some compatible minors include Environmental Studies, Management and Engineering Science.
- 3) There are approved substitutions for the OSHM fundamental courses:
 - a. BIO 105 = BIO 104 or BIO 120 or CMB 155 & CMB 156
 - b. CHM 109 = CHM 115
 - c. STA 215 = STA 220
 - d. MTH 125 = MTH 201 or MTH 122
 - e. PHY 200 = PHY 220 or PHY 230
 - f. BMS 202 = BMS 208 or BMS 250 or BMS 251
 - g. CHM 230 = CHM 232
 - h. PSY 101 = ECO 210 or ECO 211

Honors

The Frederik Meijer Honors College and the Occupational Safety and Health Management Department have approved the following substitutions for the honors curriculum:

- 1) OSH 416 fulfills the HNR 251 requirement.
- 2) OSH 440 fulfills the HNR 401 and HNR 499 requirements.

Students are encouraged to plan ahead and submit a proposal for how they plan to fulfill the HNR 200 requirement. All students must complete 3 credits of HNR 200 before graduation. It can be taken as a 1-credit, 2-credit, or 3-credit course. There are three options for fulfilling this honors requirement: **pre-approved activity**, **pre-approved course substitution**, or **an activity or course**. Please work with an honors advisor to determine the best fit for you.
