PERISHABLE ITEMS

- Meat (chicken, fish beef, ground turkey, and pork)
- Milk (dairy, almond, and coconut)
- Cheese (string, sliced, shredded)
- Fresh or Frozen Fruits
- Fresh or Frozen Vegetables
- Yogurt (regular dairy and greek)
- Eggs
- Deli sandwich meat

NON-PERISHABLE ITEMS

- Toothpaste and toothbrush
