Microsoft OneDrive is now the primary storage platform for all GVSU-managed Mac and Windows 11 computers. OneDrive replaces the legacy Private Network Drive (N: Drive) and offers a modern, secure, and accessible place to store your files. Explore more OneDrive features on Microsoft's website.

Why this matters:

OneDrive provides improved security and sharing, easier file access across devices, and better integration with the Microsoft 365 tools you use every day.

All data from the Private Network Drive has already been migrated to your OneDrive. If you've already made the switch, access to the Private Network Drive has been removed.

The Private Network Drive will be fully phased out on February 2, 2026, and access will be discontinued at that time. In January, we'll send direct communication to anyone still using their N: Drive.

Getting Started:

- Mac users: Log in to the OneDrive client when prompted.
- Windows 11 users: No action needed; OneDrive is already connected.
