When you mouse over one of the green squares, you will see an option in blue that says Connect.



Right click (two figure tap) the word Connect and select Copy link address



Open VNC Viewer and in the address box, right click and select Paste



You will need to edit the address that is pasted in the address box, by **removing the vnc://** and leaving only the address, as below:



Once that is done, hit enter on the keyboard and the connect will initiate.



Select Continue to begin

You will need to use your Grand Valley credentials to authenticate. Once you have entered these in, click OK to login to the Macintosh screen.
