







Instructions for Windows users for accessing the Mac Remote Labs







Once it has been installed, go to the following URL:


and **Select** either the iMac Lab or the MacMini Lab.




The left side gives you the option for a list view of available Macintoshes or a map view. The right-hand side displays the number of Macintoshes available and how many are in use. Click on List view or Map view




When you mouse over one of the green squares, you will see an option in blue that says Connect.




Right click (two figure tap) the word **Connect** and select **Copy link address**




Open VNC Viewer and in the address box, **right click** and **select Paste**



You will need to edit the address that is pasted in the address box, by **removing the vnc://** and leaving only the address, as below:




Once that is done, hit enter on the keyboard and the connect will initiate.



Select Continue to begin

You will need to use your Grand Valley credentials to authenticate. Once you have entered these in, click OK to login to the Macintosh screen.



At this point, you will be at the login screen of the Macintosh. You will enter your Grand Valley credentials again, and at that point, you will be logged into the Macintosh and have full access to the software installed on it.
