

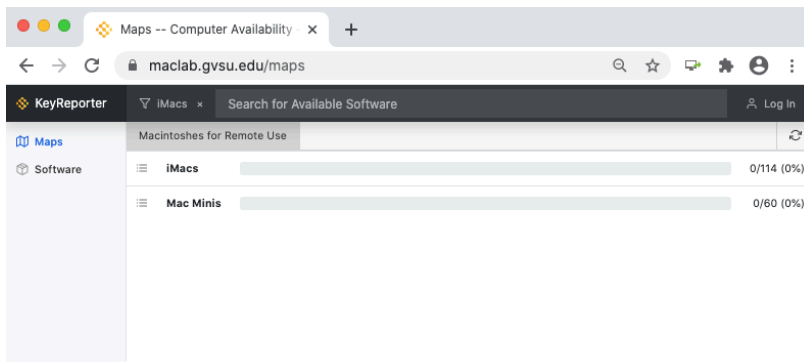
Remoting into a Macintosh from a Mac

On the left hand side, you will see the name of the labs, with a list view or a map view available.



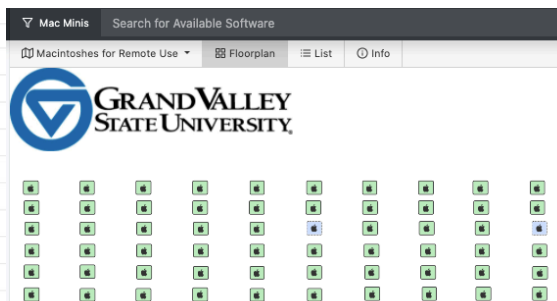
On the right hand side, you will see the number available and the percentage that are in use.

Clicking on either the list or map view, will get you to a screen with the Macintoshes that you will be remoting into.

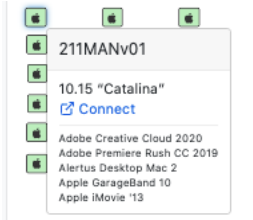

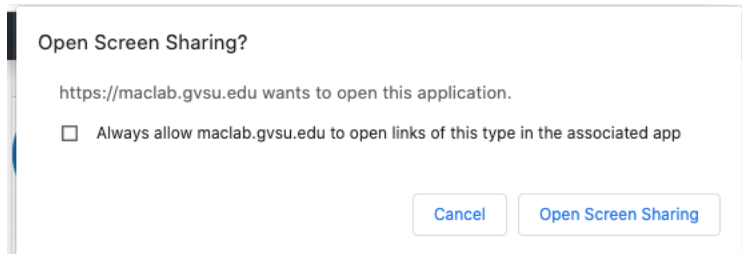
Map View:



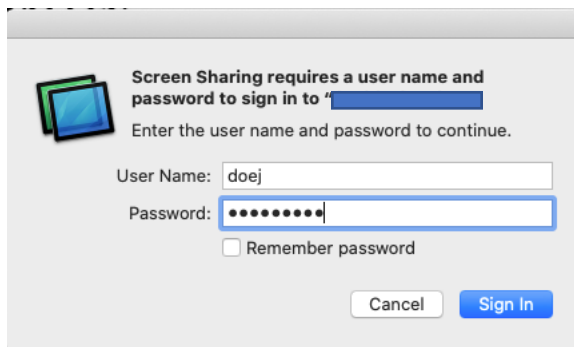
By clicking on any one of the green squares with the Apple on it, you will be presented with dialog box with a Connect option in blue.



Click on the word Connect and the Macintosh you are connecting from, will startup the Screen Sharing application. Select Open Screen Sharing



You will then be presented with a login dialog box.



You will enter your GVSU Network credentials and password. This is the login name and password you would use to login to a machine if you were in the lab.
