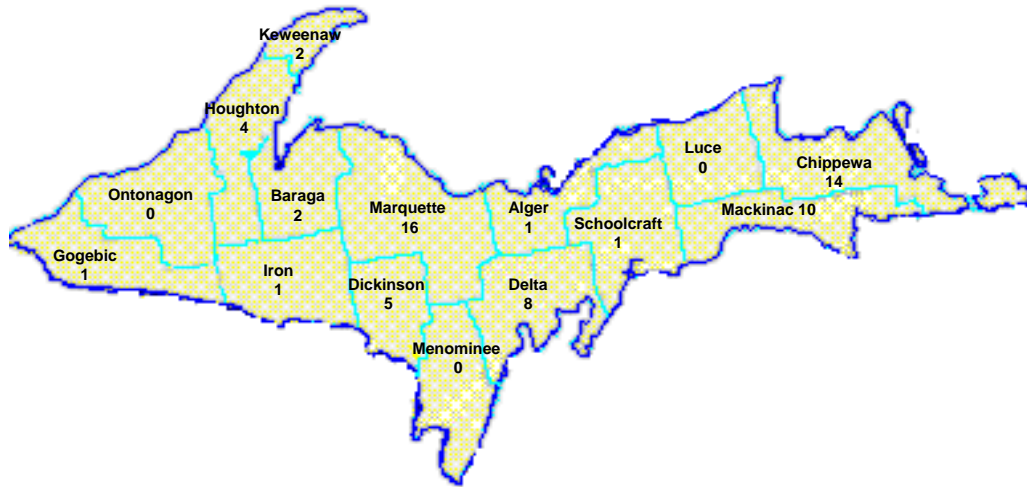

SPRING/SUMMER SESSION 2016



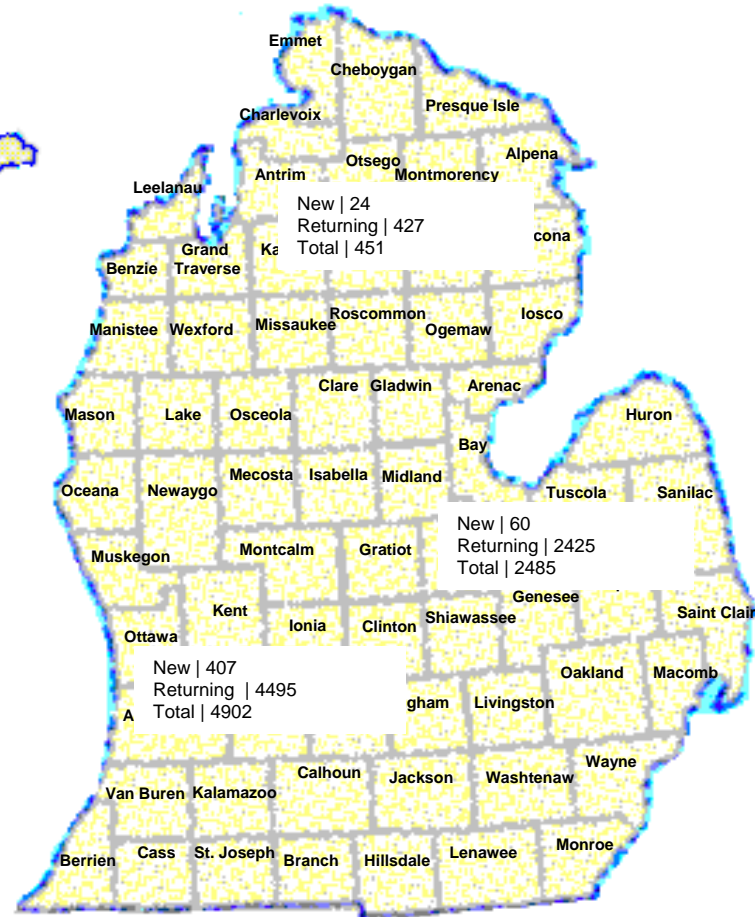
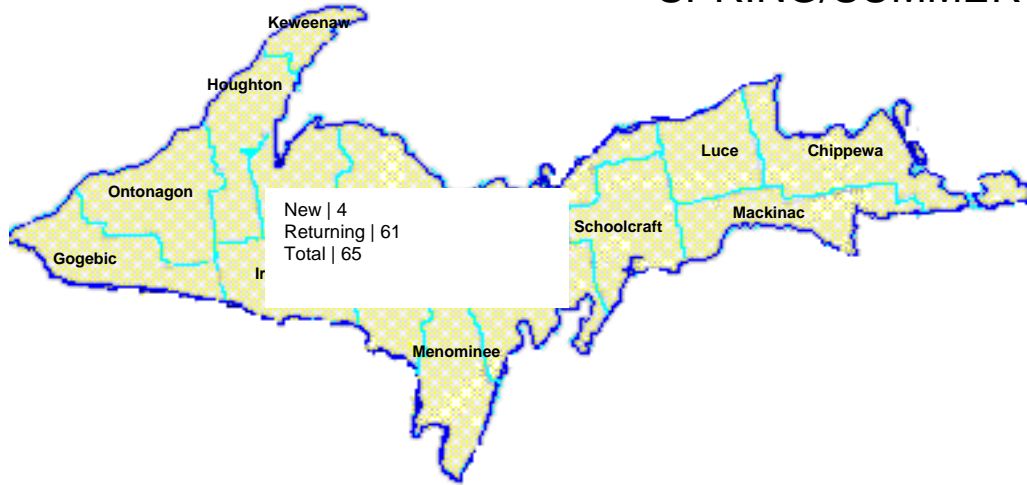
