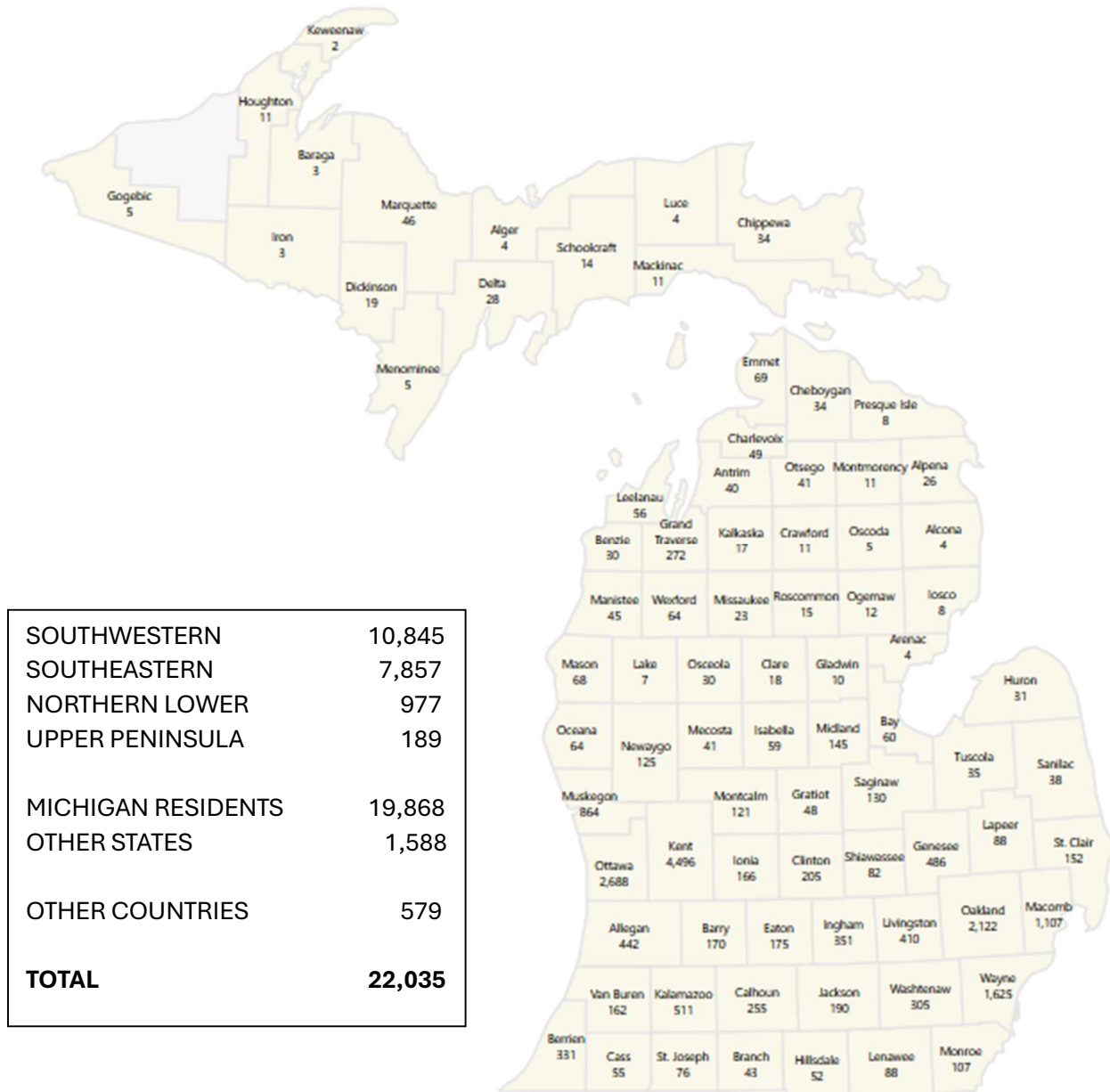

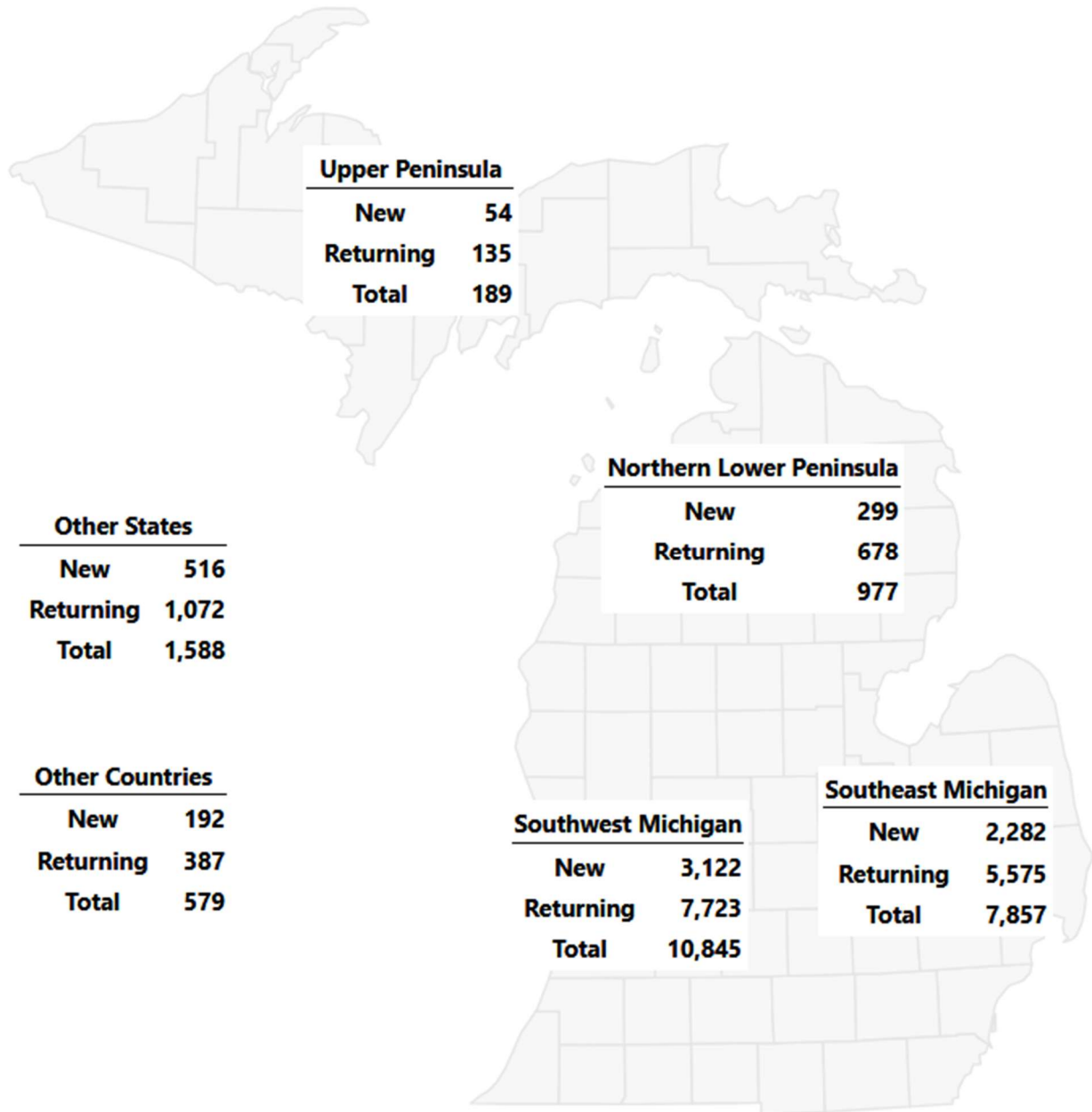
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN
