

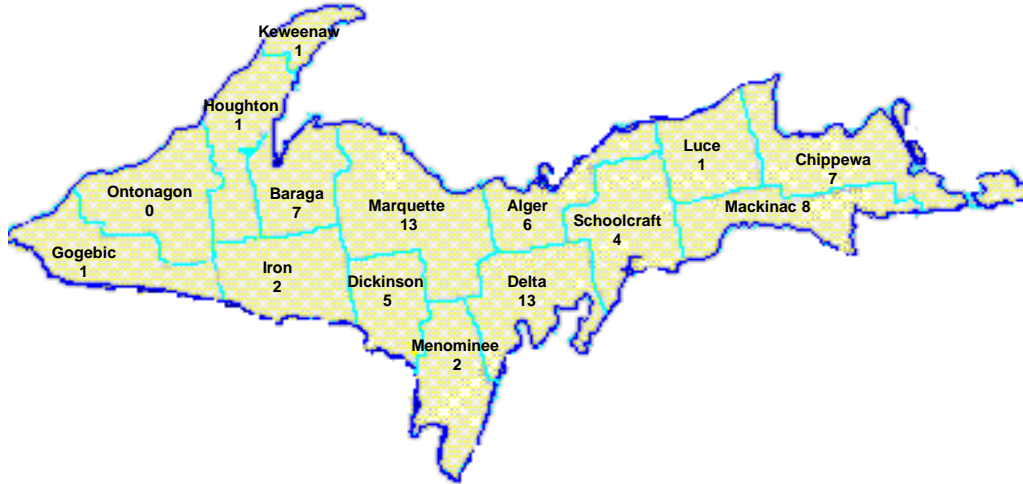

SPRING/SUMMER 2017



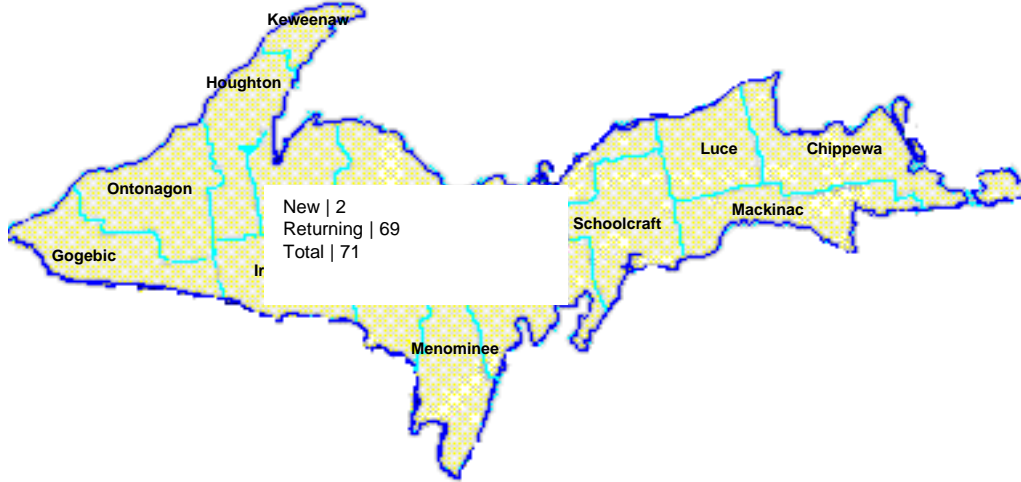

## GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN BY STUDENT CLASSIFICATION SPRING/SUMMER 2017

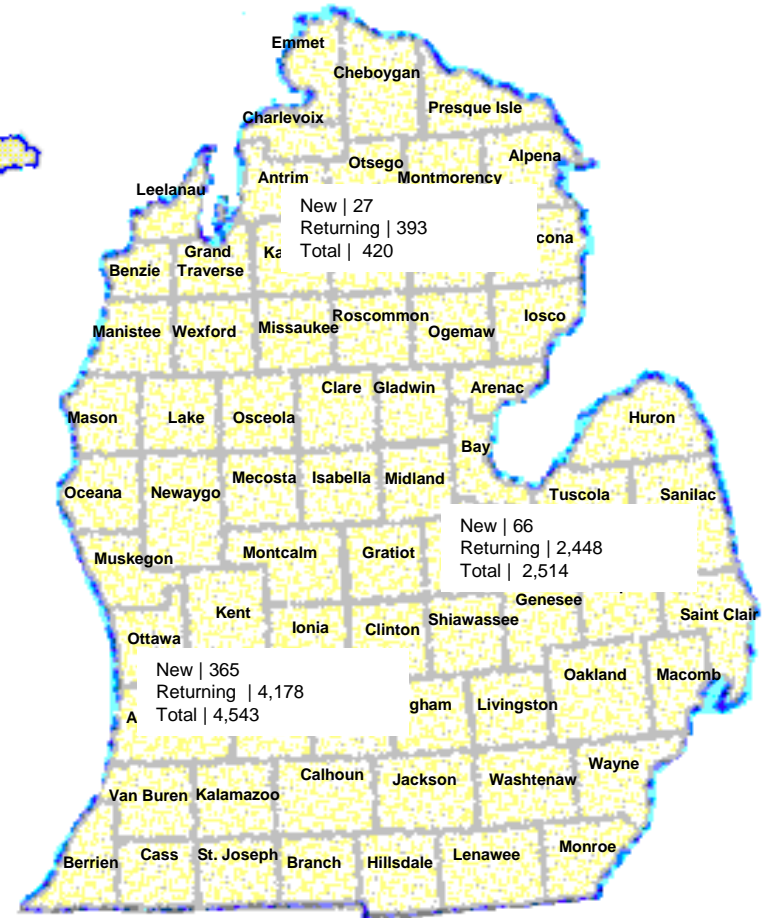
