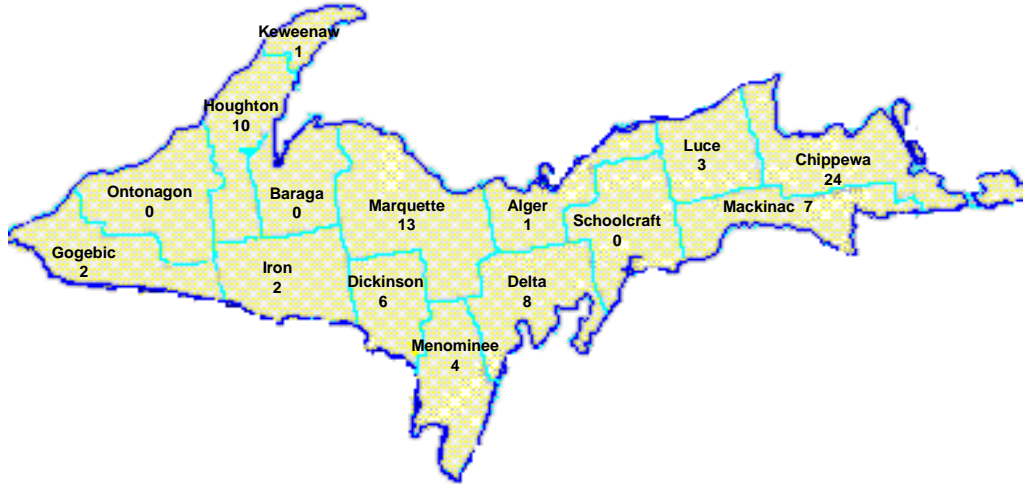

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN SPRING/SUMMER 2022



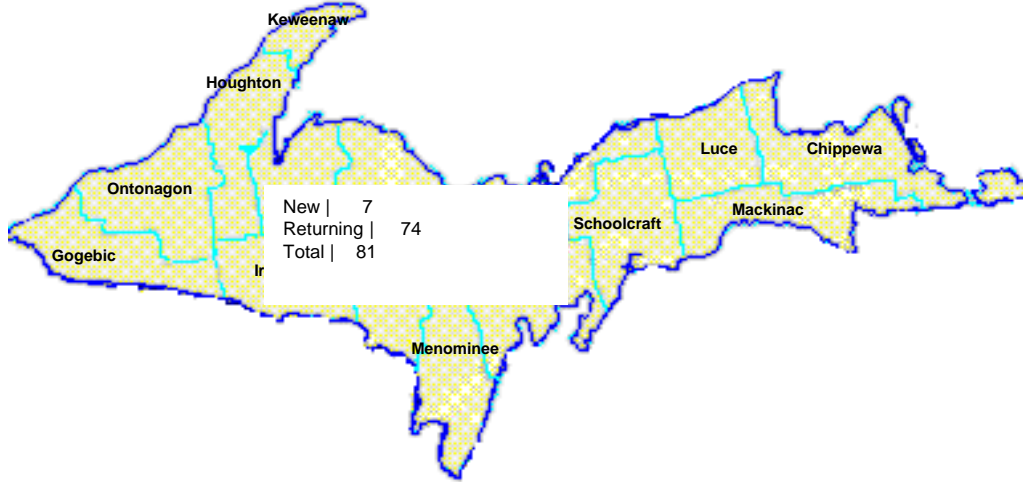
