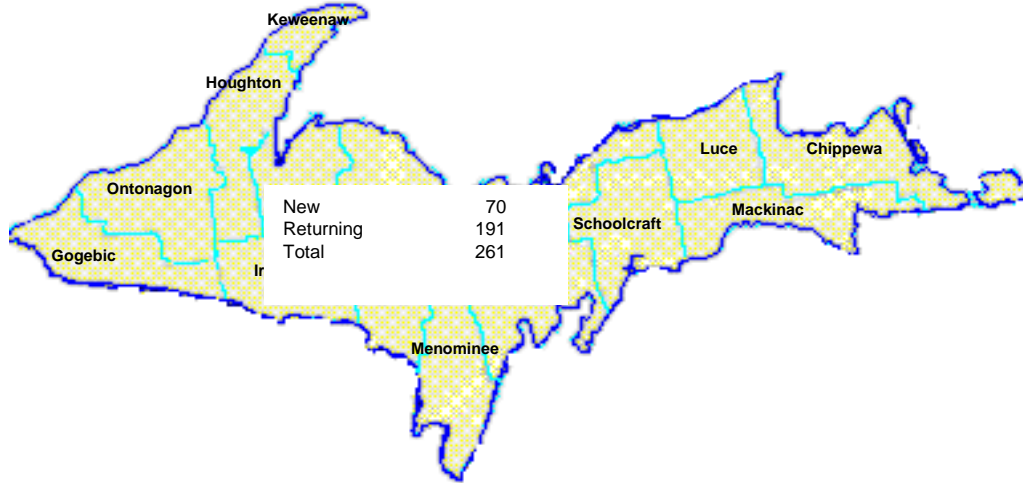

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN BY STUDENT CLASSIFICATION FALL SEMESTER 2011

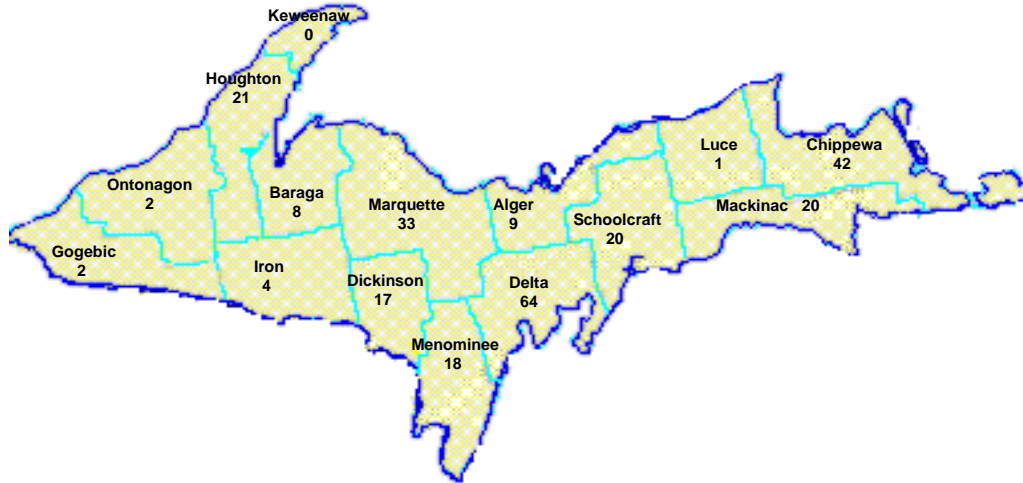
