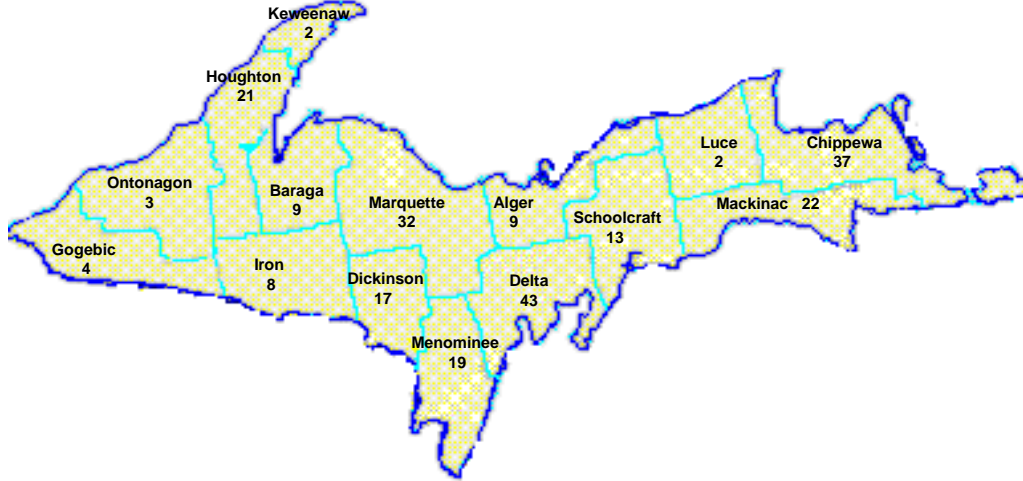

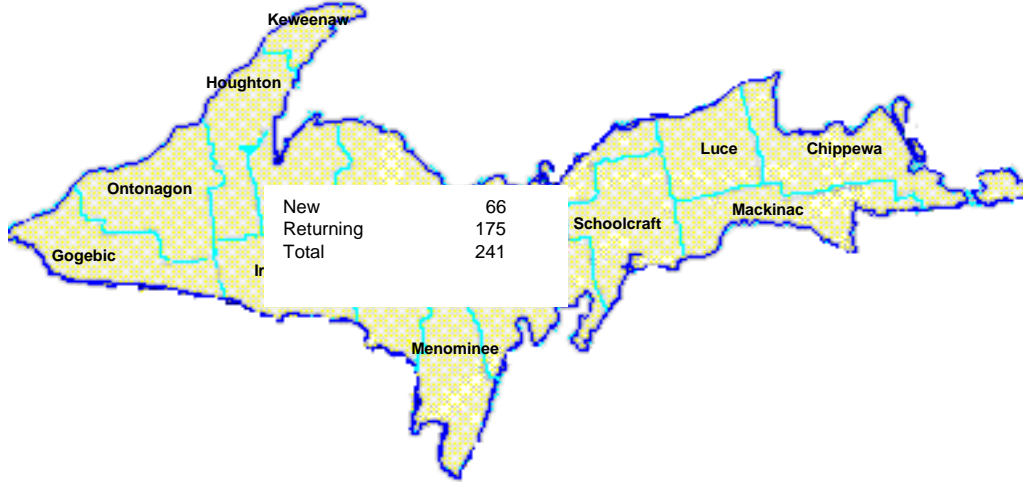
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN FALL SEMESTER 2012
