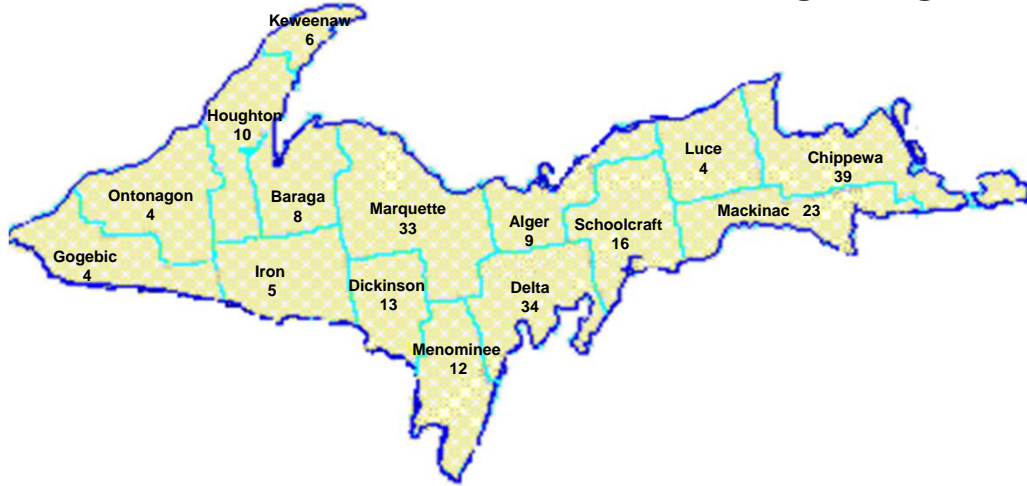

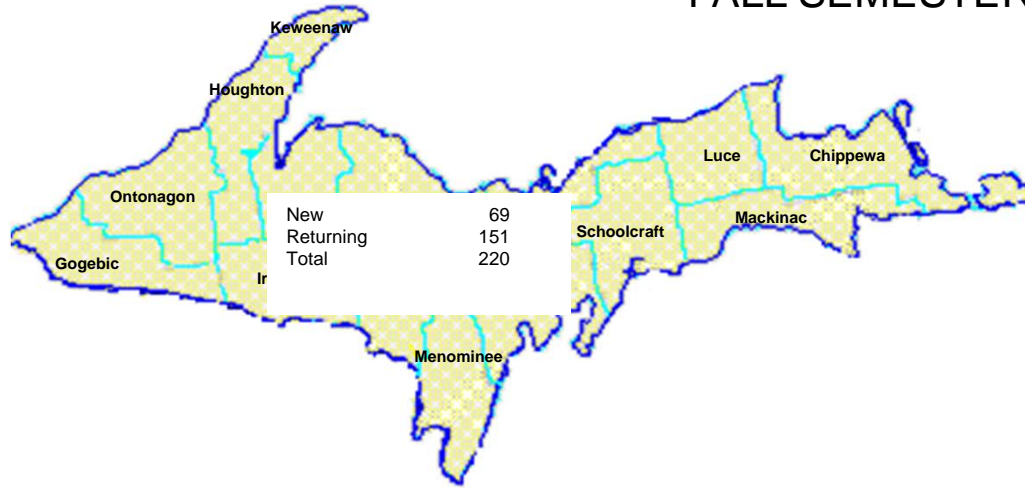
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN
