

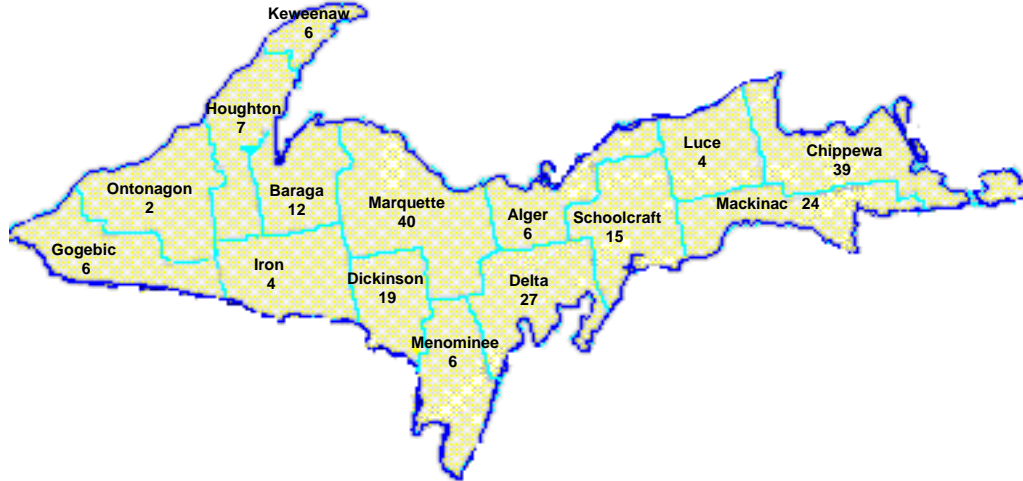

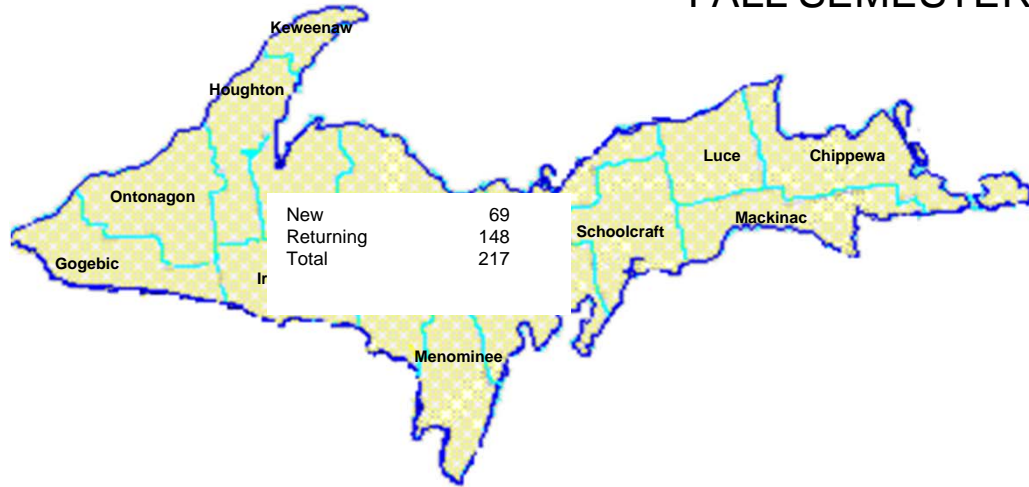
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN FALL SEMESTER 2015
