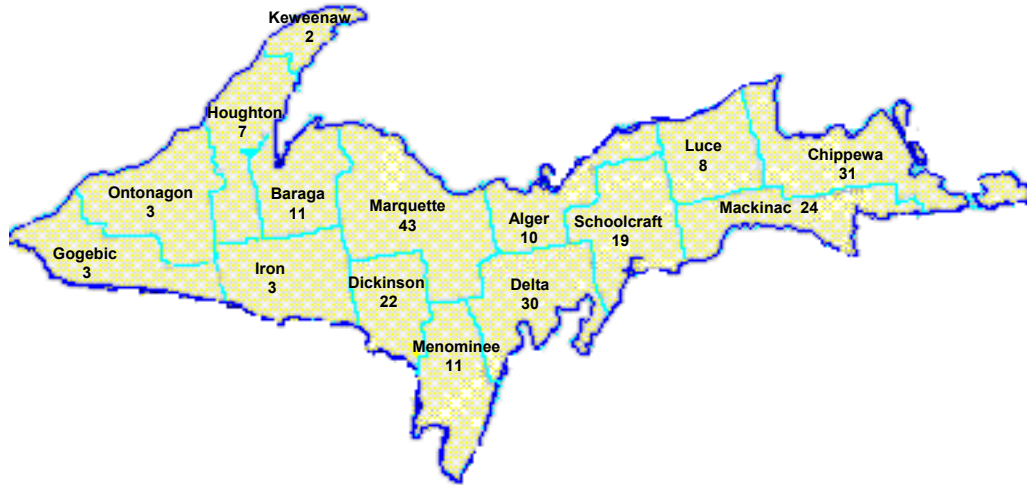

FALL SEMESTER 2016



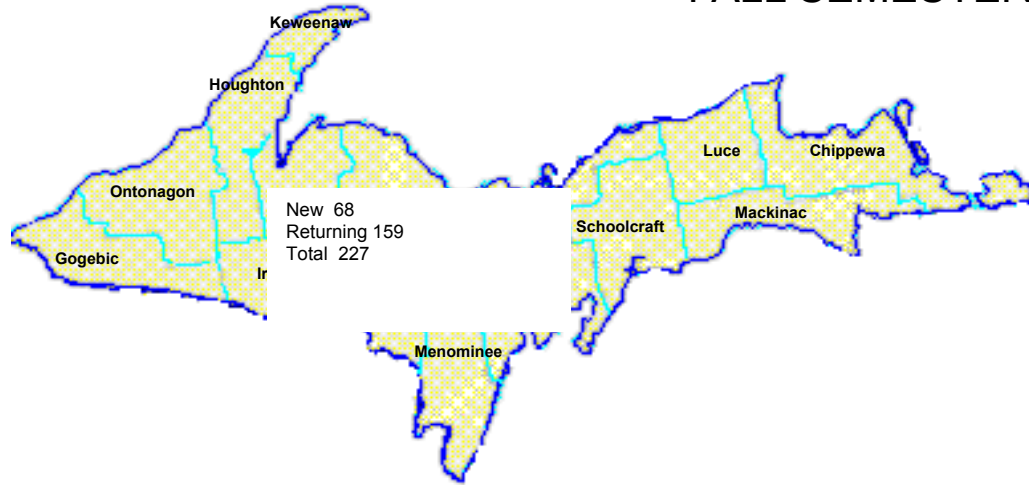
