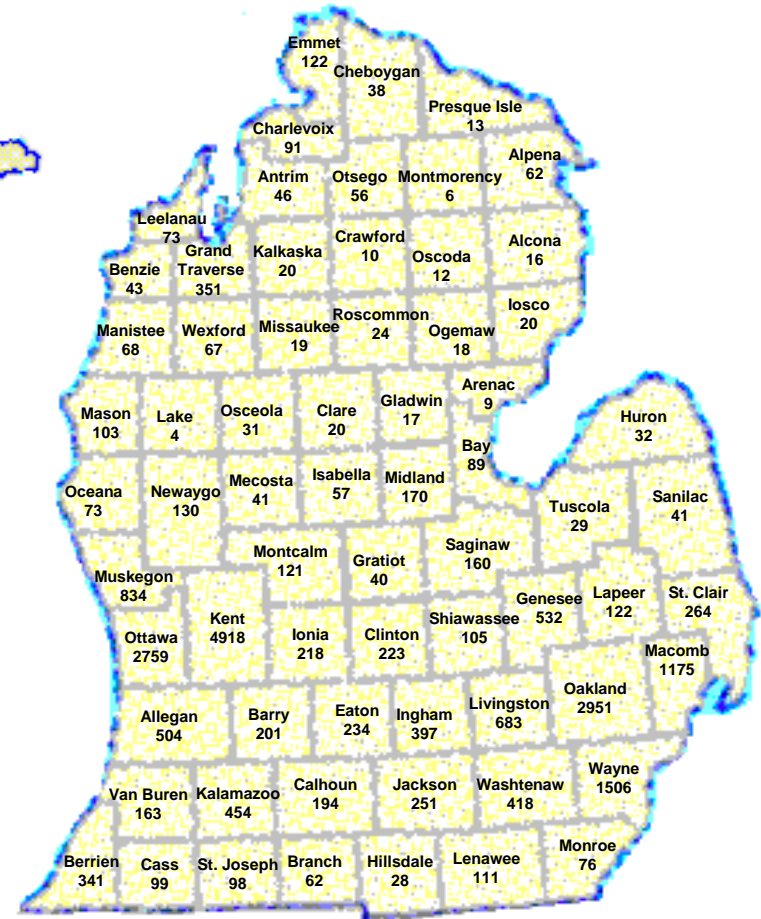
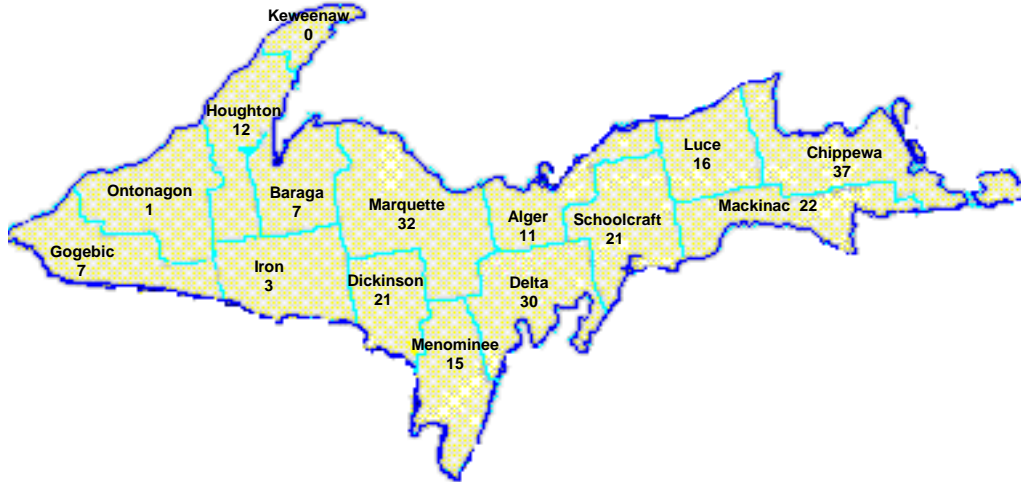

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN FALL SEMESTER 2018



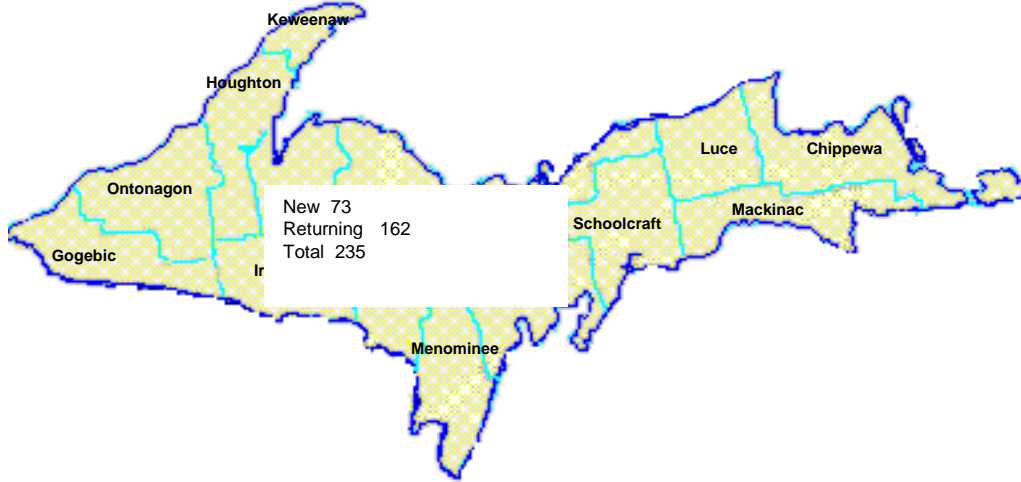

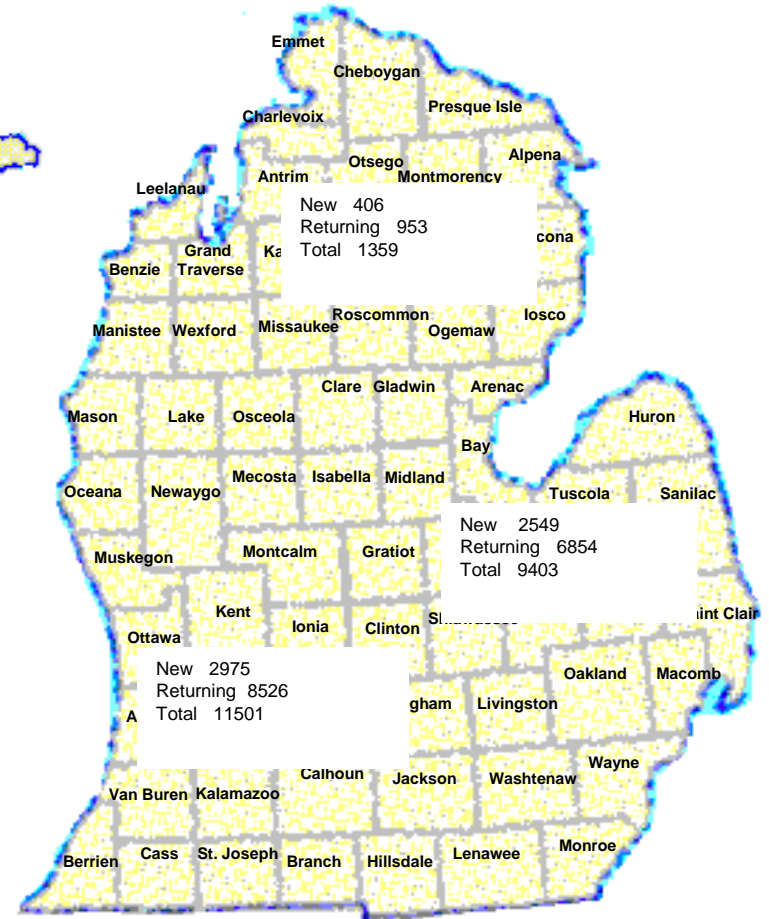
