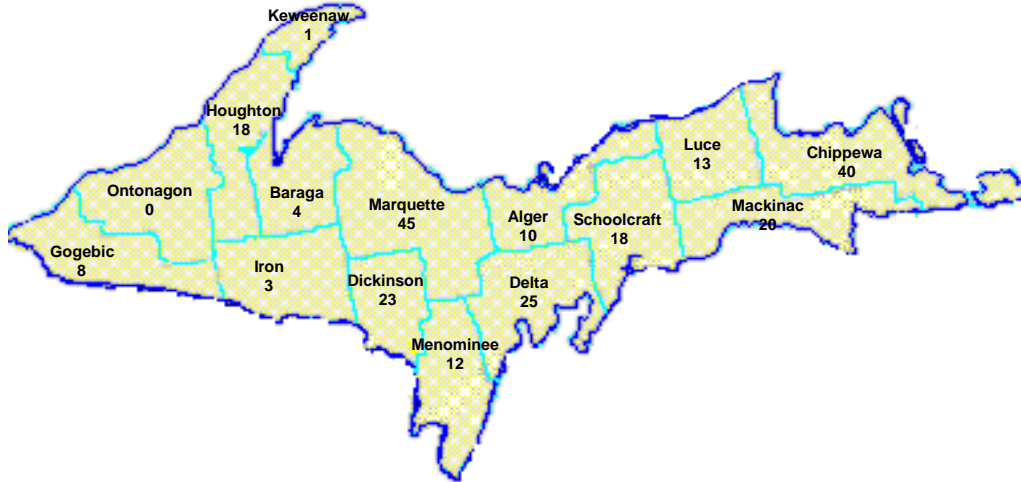

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN FALL SEMESTER 2019



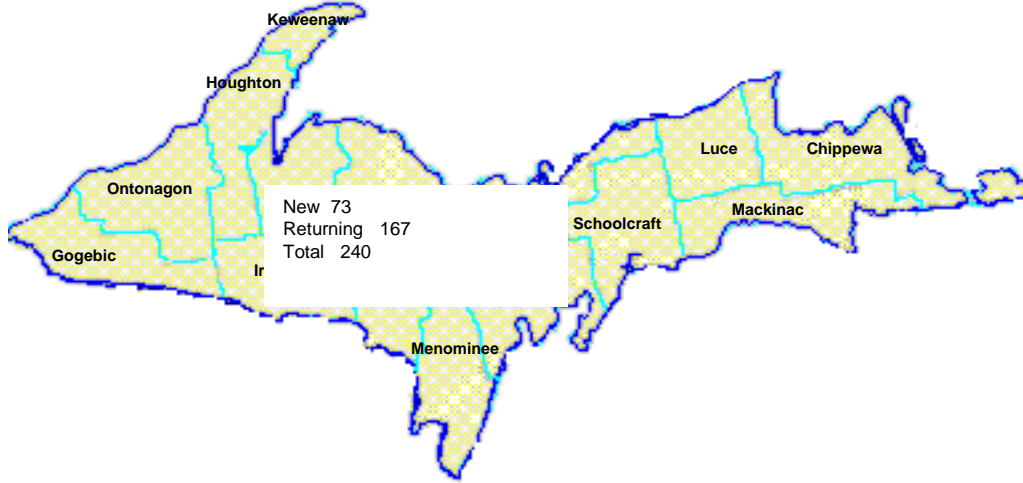

FALL SEMESTER 2019

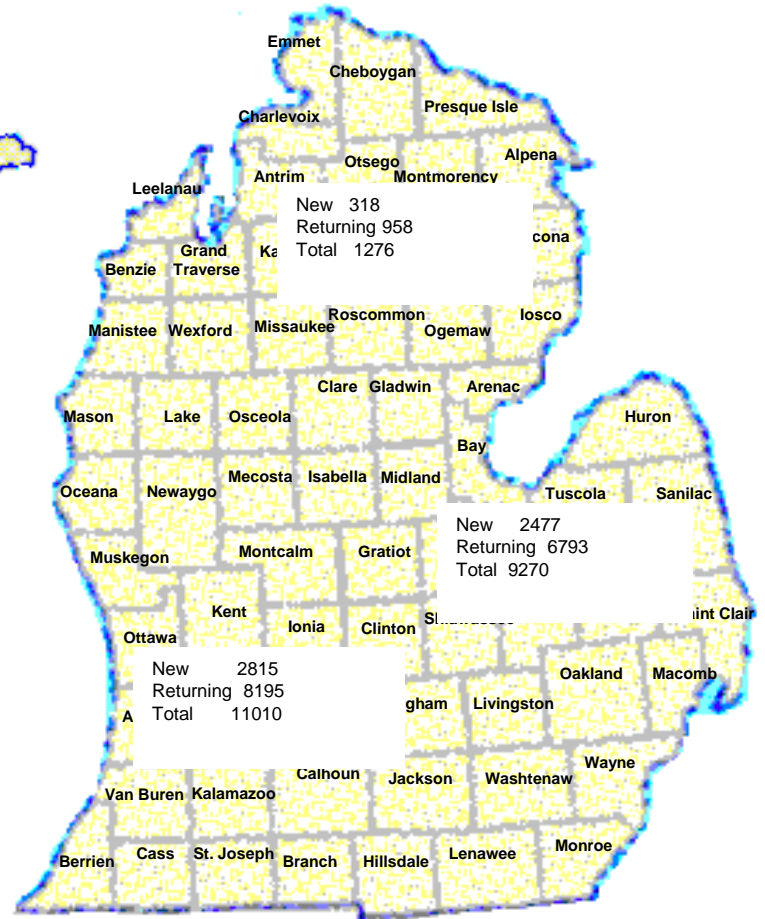
