

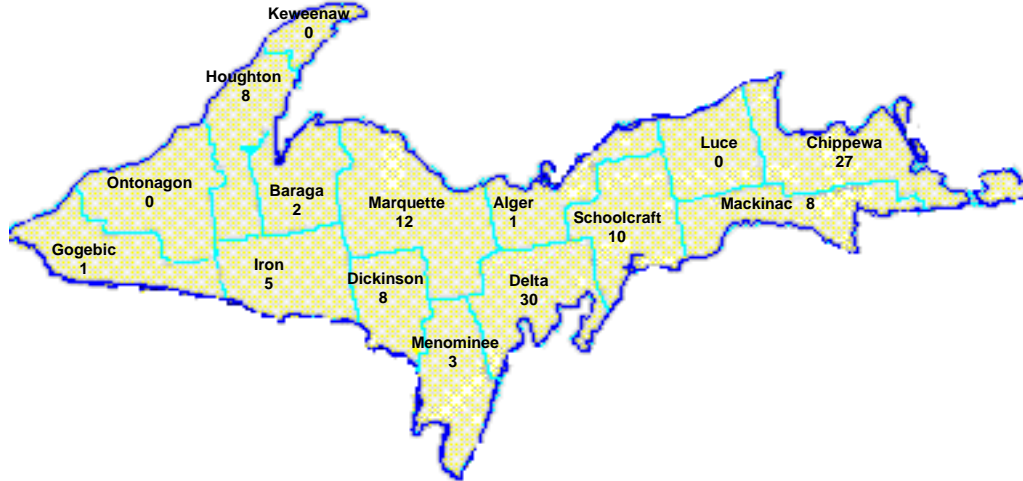

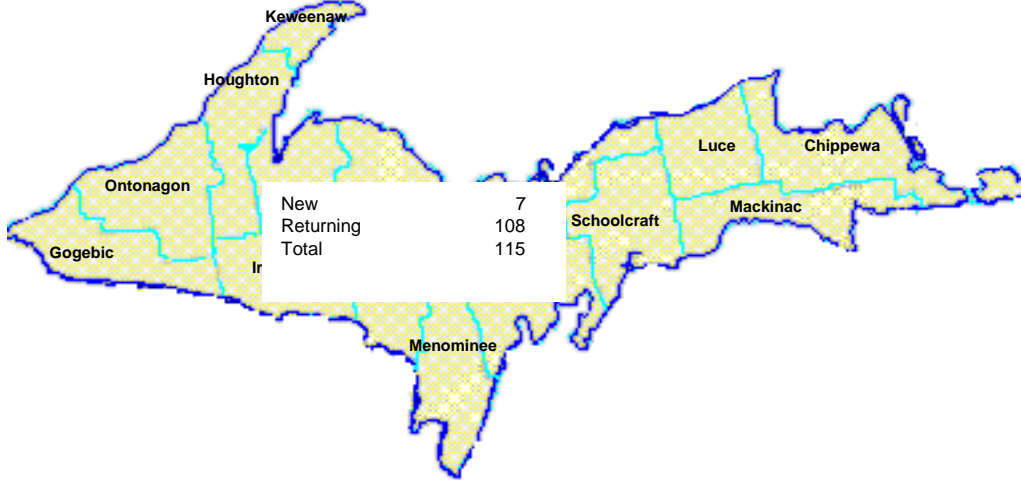
## GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN SPRING/SUMMER SESSION 2011
