

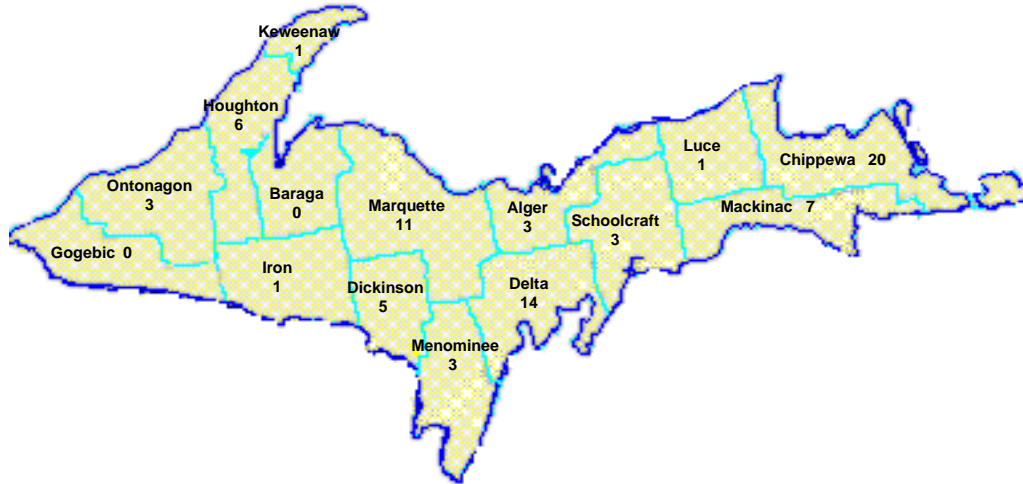

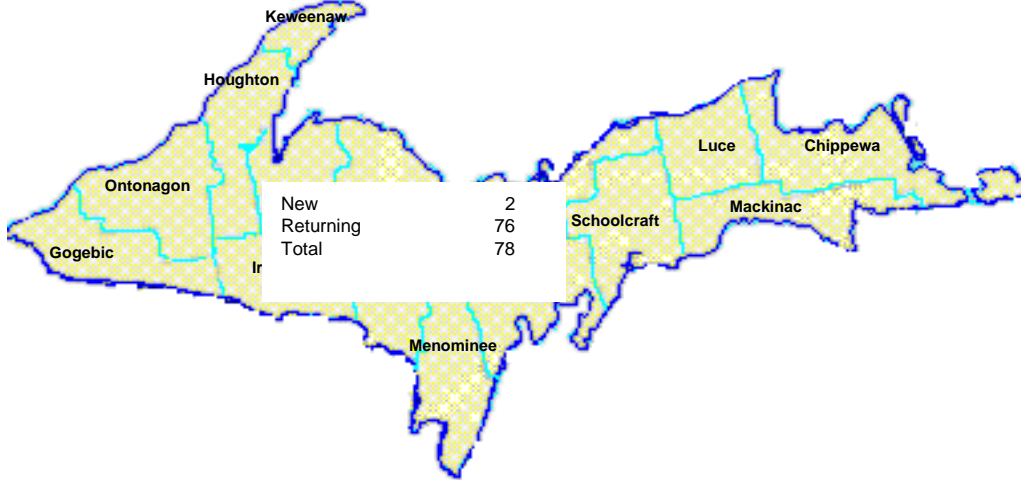
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN
