

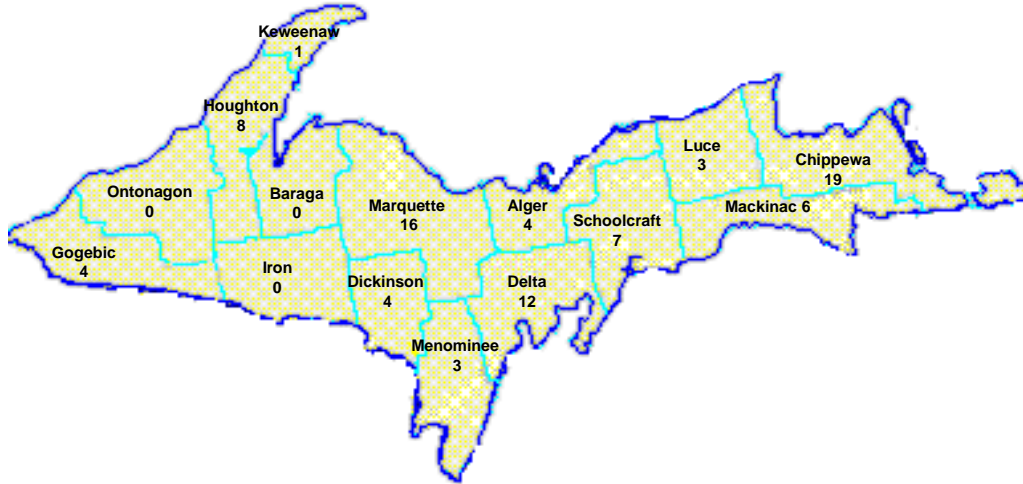

## GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN SPRING/SUMMER 2020



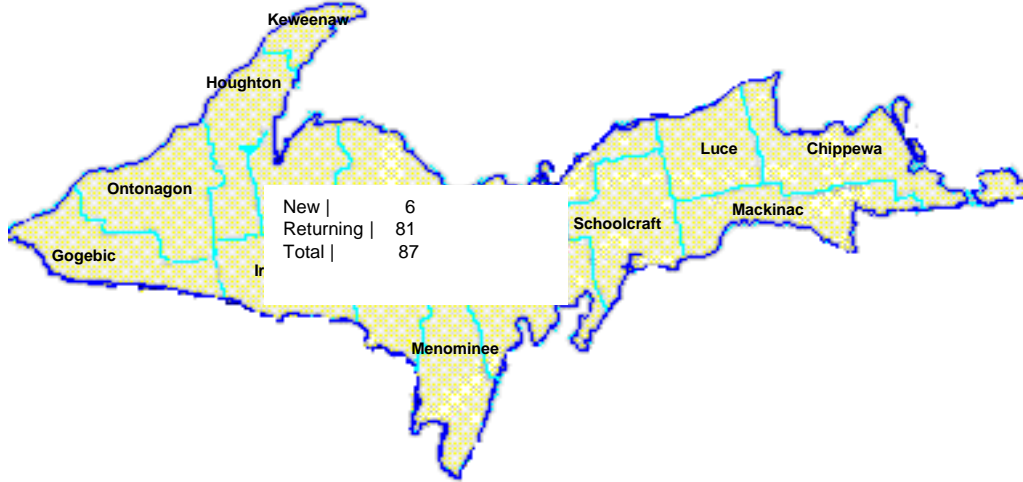
