

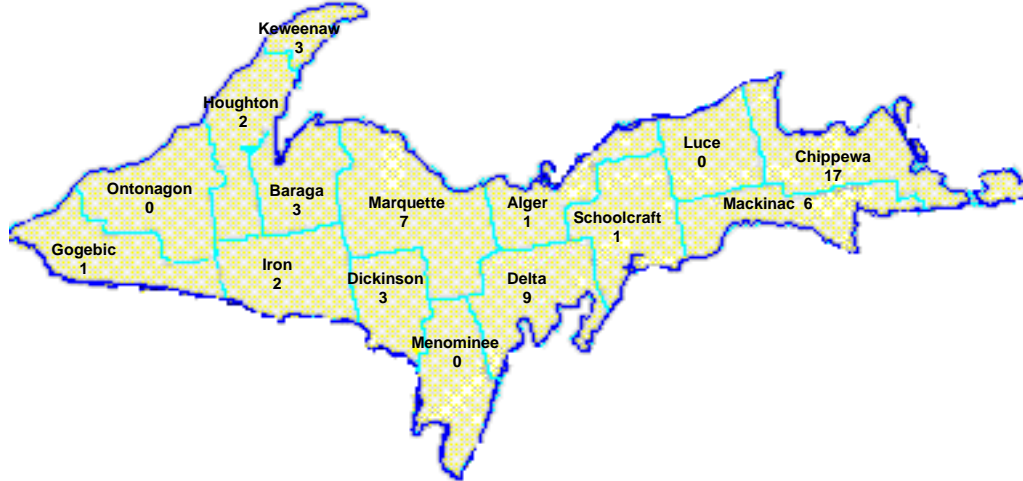

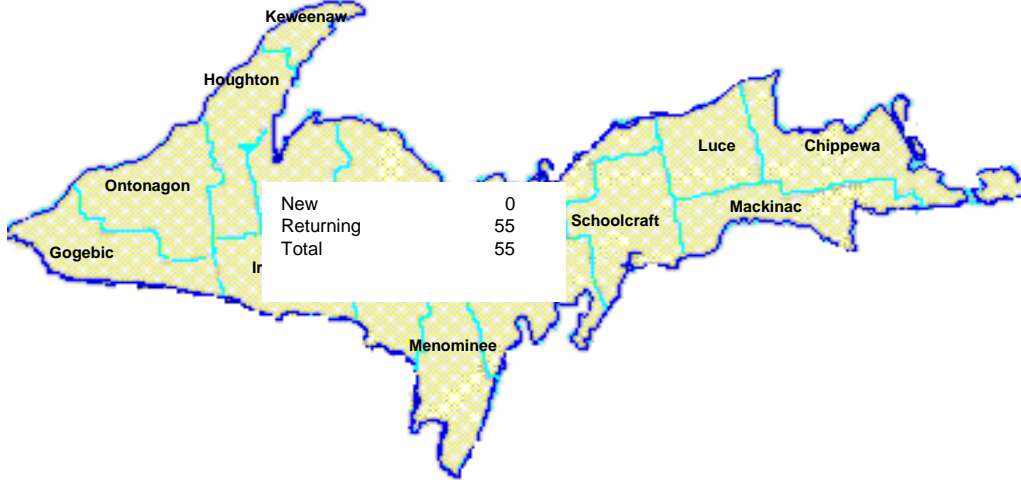
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN
