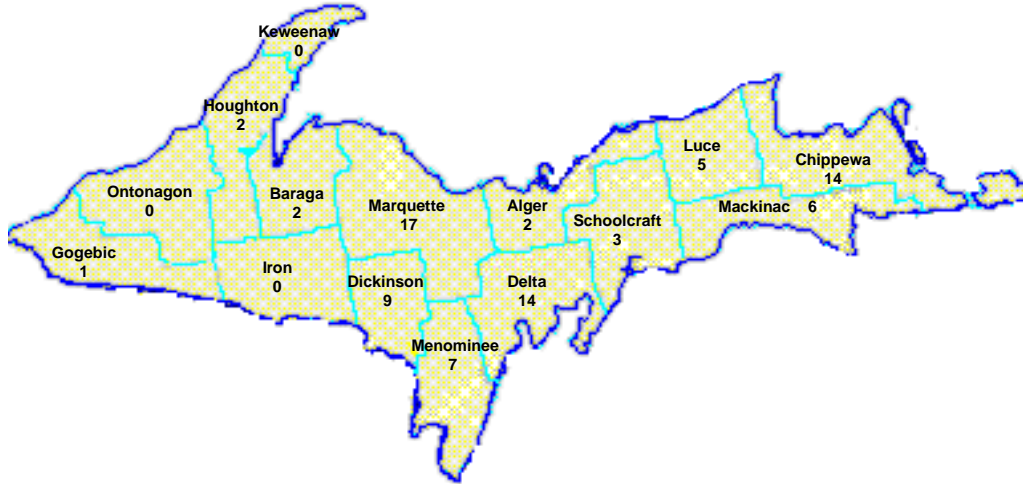

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN SPRING/SUMMER 2018



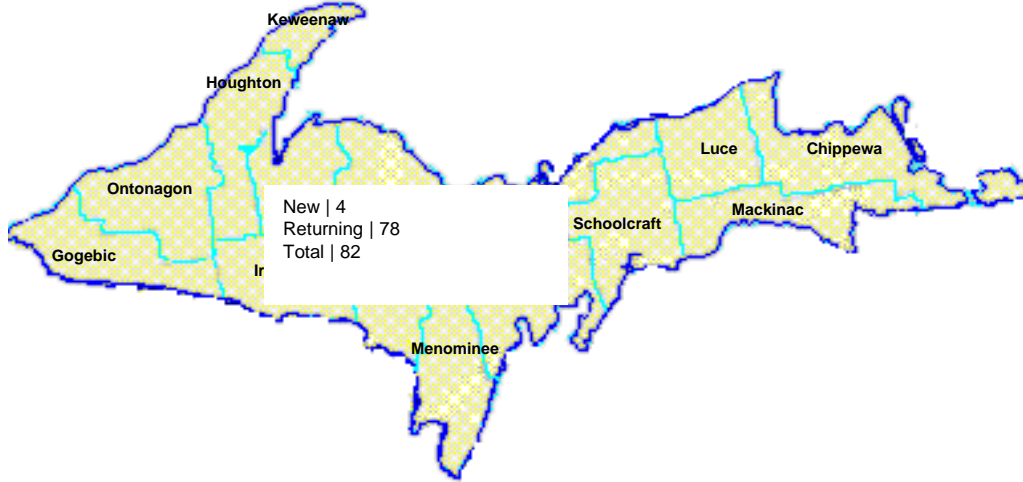

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN BY STUDENT CLASSIFICATION SPRING/SUMMER 2018

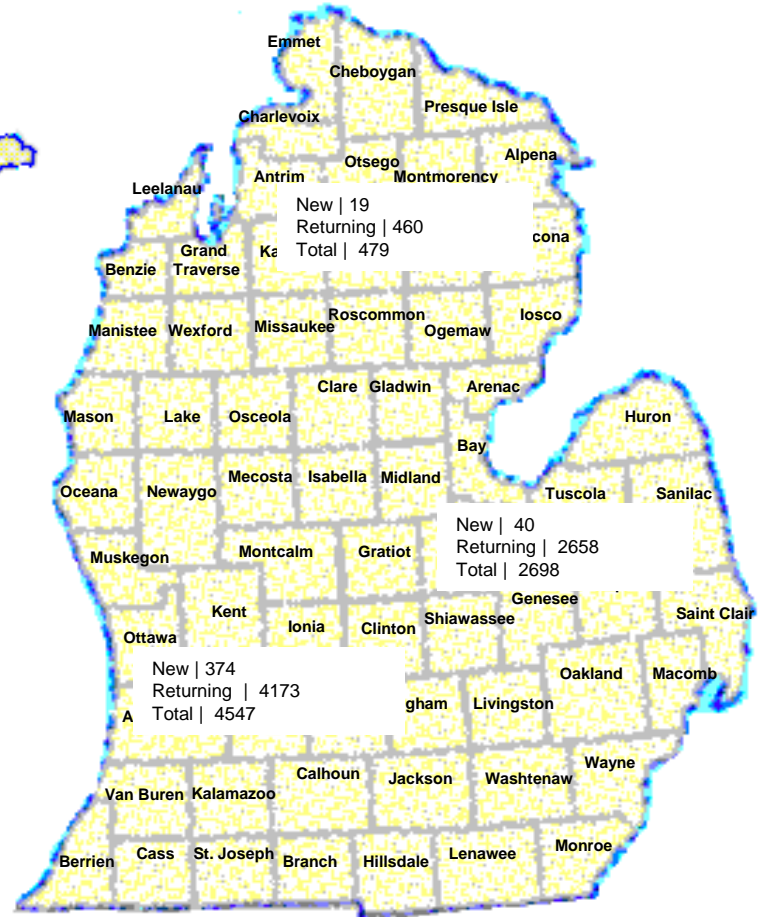
