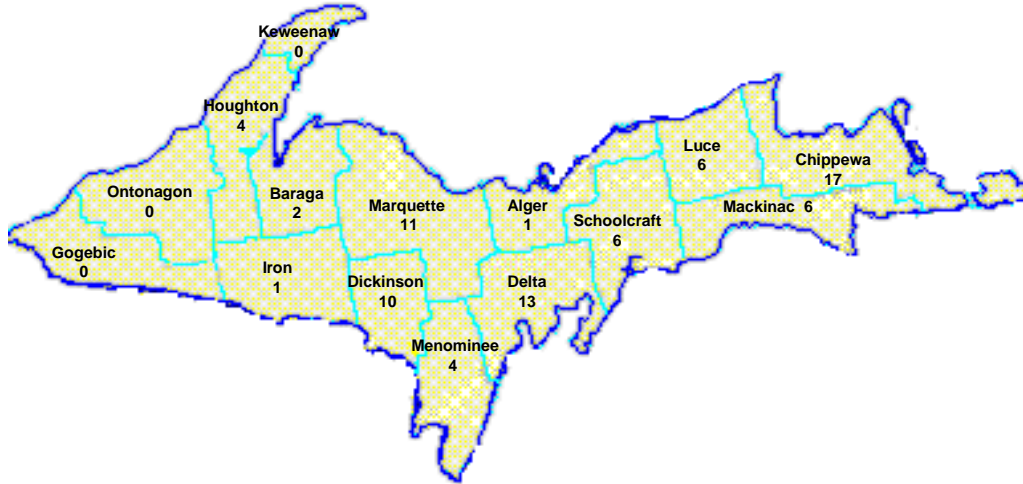

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN SPRING/SUMMER 2019



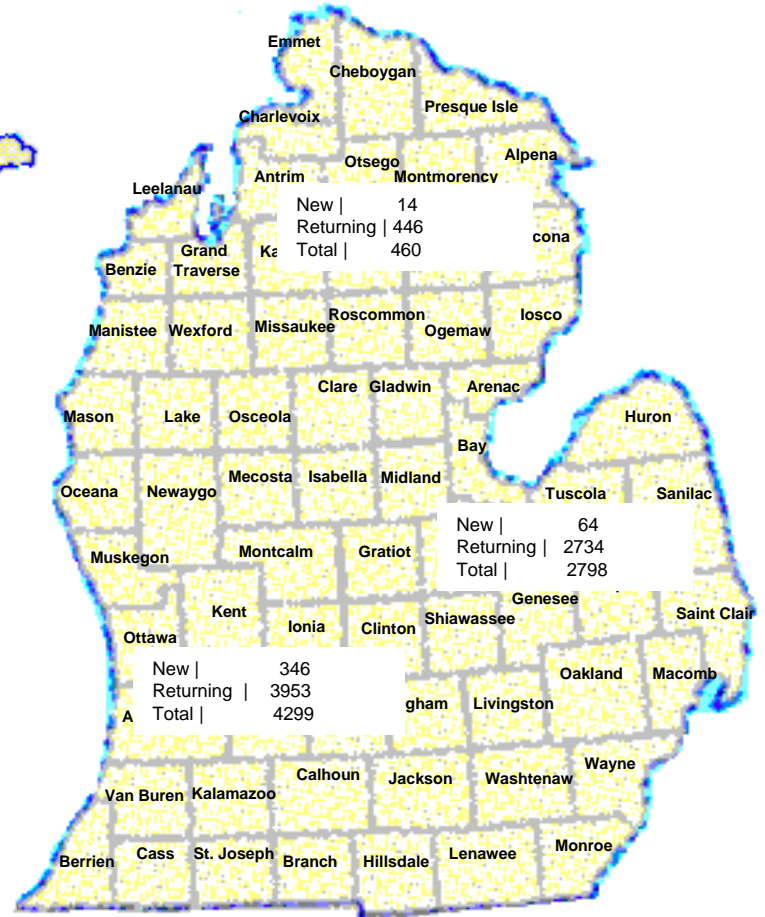
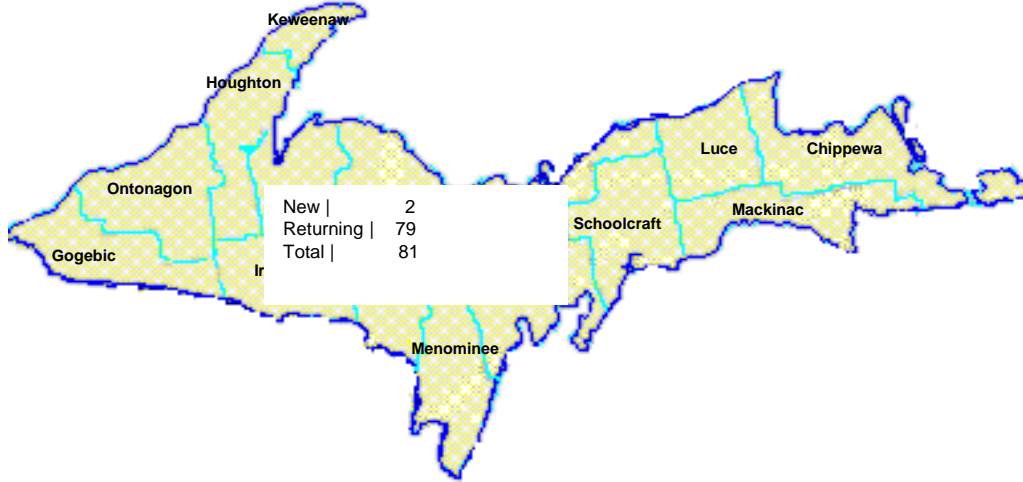
