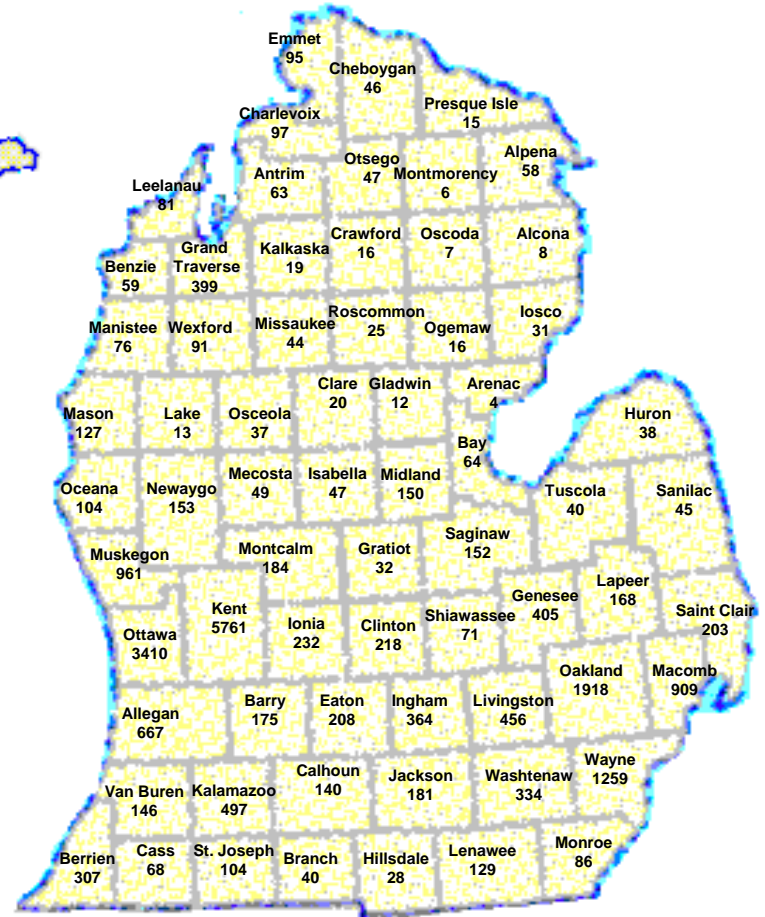
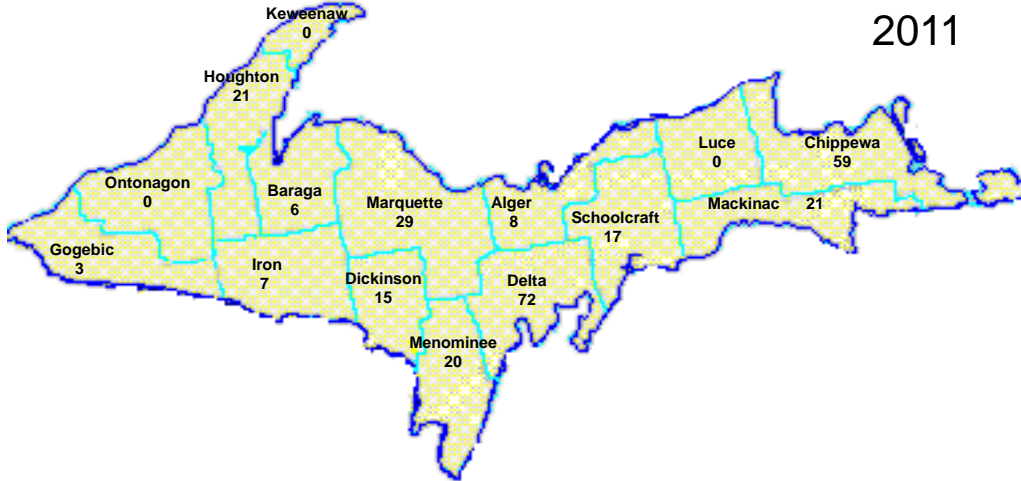

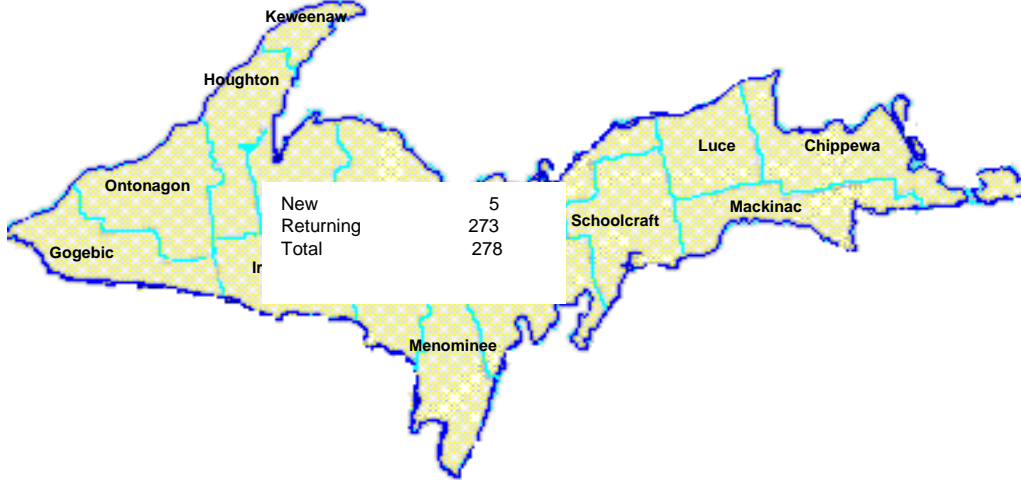
## GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN WINTER SEMESTER 2011
