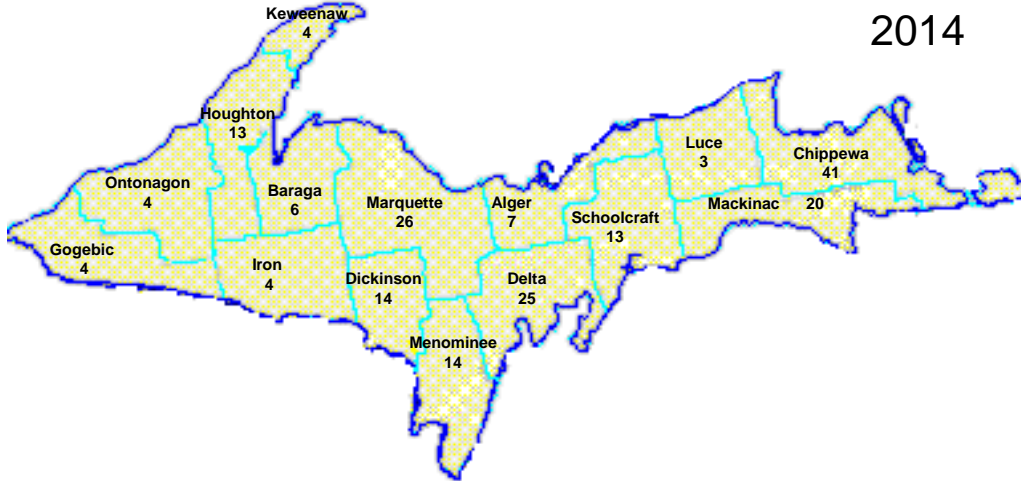

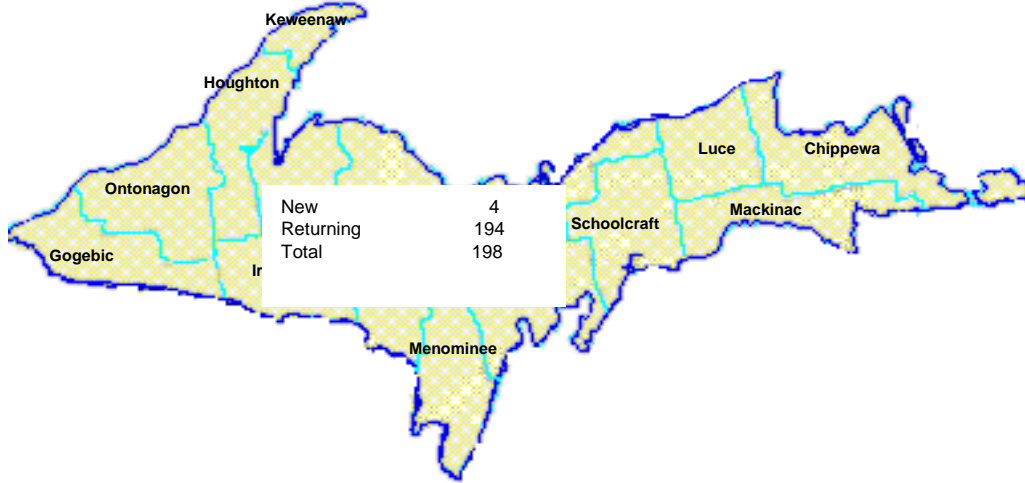
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN WINTER SEMESTER 2014
