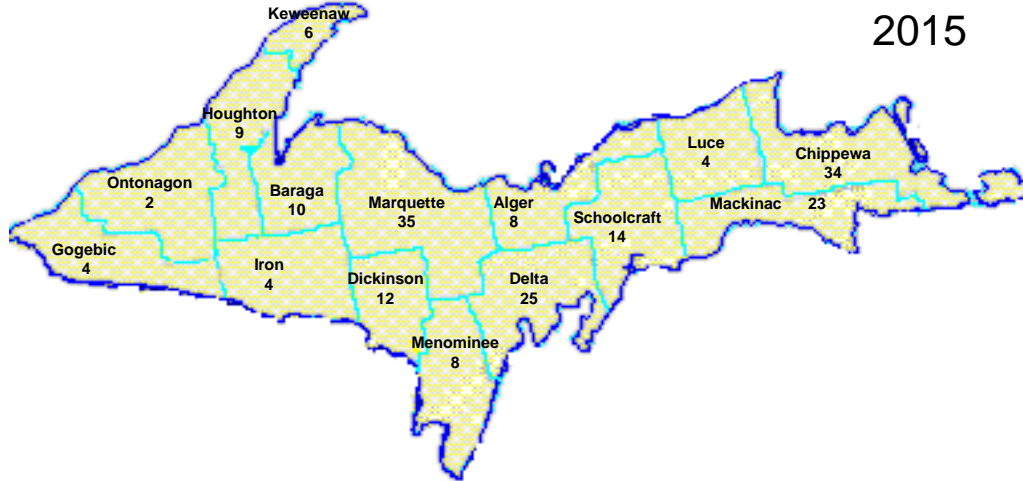

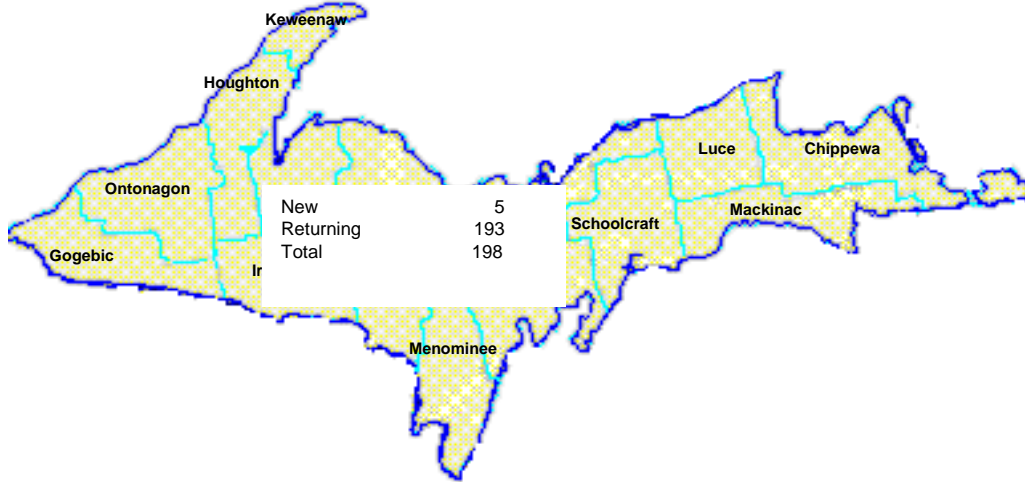
GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN WINTER SEMESTER 2015
