

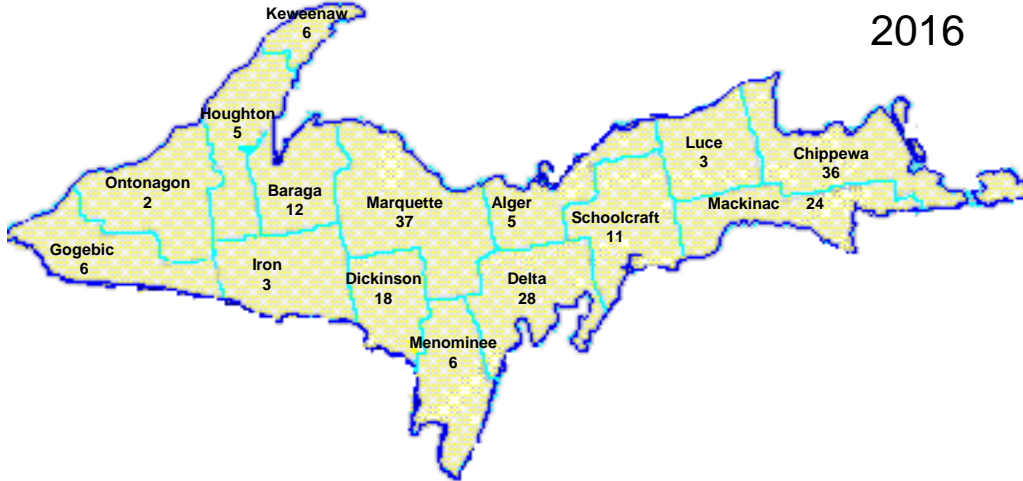

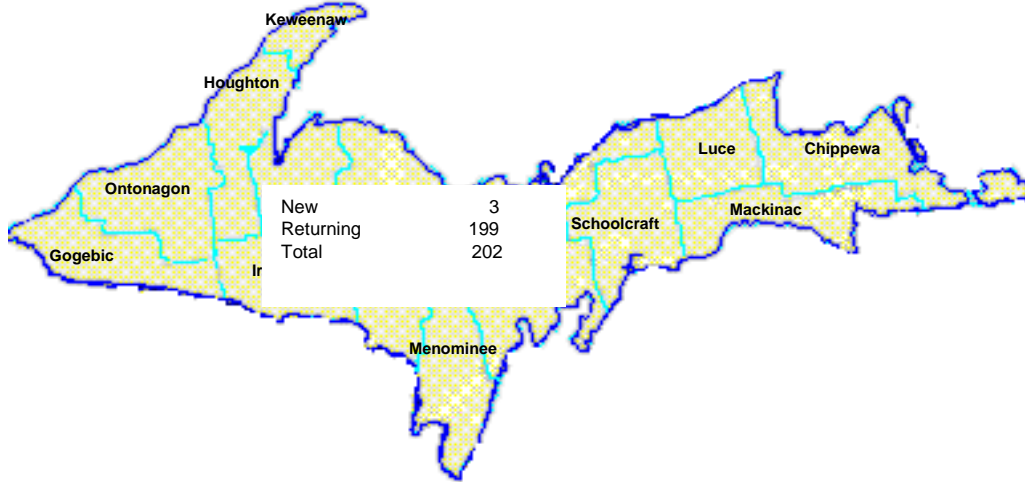
## GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN WINTER SEMESTER 2016
