#### MAJOR OF THE MONTH

The mission of the program is to prepare students for supervised practice leading to eligibility for the CDR credentialing exam to become a registered dietitian nutritionist, graduate degree programs, and entry-level employment in the field of nutrition and dietetics. Applied Food and Nutrition is a growing field; the Bureau of Labor Statistics indicates employment opportunities are expected to increase by 15% by 2026. Studying AFN at GVSU includes experiential learning, with hands-on work in state-of-the-art facilities, including simulation laboratories, culinary laboratories, and the GVSU Sustainable Agriculture Project farm.
