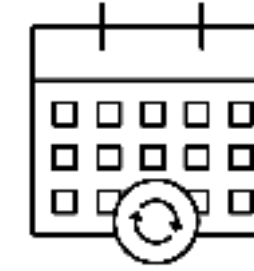

Help Article Spotlight: Troubleshooting Workday PDFs

Having trouble viewing PDFs in Workday? You're not alone! This common issue often occurs with:

- PDF portfolios (files with multiple attachments)
- Emails saved as PDFs from Outlook

Here are a few quick tips to help resolve the issue:

- ✓ **Avoid** uploading PDF portfolios.
- ✓ **Download PDFs** to view them with Adobe software.
- ✓ **Adjust Outlook Settings:** Turn off "Output Adobe PDF Portfolio when creating a new PDF file."
