


June Project Update Recap


Workday Academic Progress Report Replacing Degree Works

Currently students, advisors, and faculty use DegreeWorks (MyPath) to track degree progress. Starting in January 2027, GVSU will begin to use Workday's Academic Progress Report (APR), which includes tools for academic planning and registration.

In March 2027, students will register for the Fall 2027 and Winter 2028 semesters in Workday. Important to note is that registration for Summer 2027 classes will still be done in Banner. Thus, there will be a transition period where we will be temporarily using both Banner and Workday.
