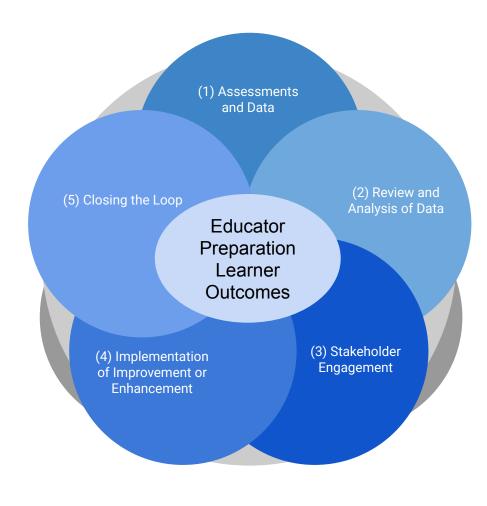

## **GVSU - COE - Field Experiences**

- Enrollment is at or above other universities
- We place more than 650 students every year (apprenticeships/internships)
- Students are getting hired in districts where they intern
- Students are enrolled full time while placed at your schools
- Mentors need 3 years of successful teaching experience
- Very important that the mentor teacher's certifications & endorsements match the student's major.



## **GVSU - COE - Field Experiences**

- Requests for mentors are emailed to the building administrator the semester ahead of the placement semester.
- Communication follow through is essential to this process.
  - Is there someone else we should contact or include in our request?
- Placement considerations include different grade levels and districts, diversity and geography.



## **GVSU - COE - Field Experiences**

- Elementary: two or more mentors in a building so that students can collaborate with someone familiar with their context
- Secondary
  - 30 observation hours in their minor content area must be done alongside apprenticeship and/or internship
  - Math apprentices placed as a pair with one mentor teacher
- Still several EL/SED students who need a placement for fall 2024



## **Placements by Semester**

Birth – Kdg – no placements	BK - Early Childhood SE Interns
Special Education — Interns only (TBD: EI, CI, LD, or ASD based on enrollment)	SE — Apprentices and Interns (TBD: EI, CI, LD, or ASD based on enrollment)
Elementary & Secondary – Apprentices and Interns	
Specials – Music, Art, Health and Physical Education (HPE) Apprentices and Interns *Soon to add World Languages	



## **Special Education Changes at GVSU**

- Five year program with 4 distinct placements
- Elementary general education certificate in addition to K-26 SE license
- SE apprenticeships are winter only
- LD and ASD endorsements now at the UG level, so we place EI, CI, LD and ASD interns
- Mentors need to hold these endorsements AND have 2-3 students with the corresponding educational label in their class



#### **Qualities of a Great Mentor Teacher**

"Not all great teachers make great mentors."

- Willing to share their professional skills and expertise.
- Positive attitude and role model.
- Exhibits enthusiasm in teaching and learning.
- Provides ongoing constructive feedback; starts with the positives.
- Demonstrates effective communication skills.

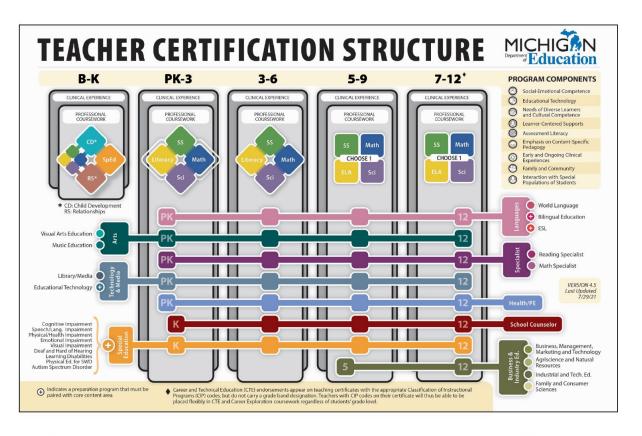
