Program Requirement Notes

- Students must complete the courses listed under *Core Area* and *Culminating Experience* headings (21 credits) to obtain Central Office Administrator certification.
- Students must apply in advance for the culminating experience. Advisor approval is required. Apply online at <http://www.gvsu.edu/coe/grad/app>. Application deadlines: May 15 for fall enrollment, September 15 for winter enrollment, and February 15 for spring/summer enrollment.
- All students must complete Responsible Conduct of Research training as a graduation requirement. This online training should be completed prior to completion of 50% of the graduate program or prior to engaging in any research activity. Certification expires after 3 years and must be current while engaged in any research activity. - Prior to enrolling in EDL 770, a fingerprinting record must be completed through the College of Education designated service. If you are convicted of a felony or misdemeanor after submitting the record, court documents must be provided to the College of Education immediately.

Important Program Policies

- Students must apply and be accepted for graduate study in the College of Education. Students who have not been accepted will not be permitted to enroll in coursework beyond 6 semester hours. A master's degree is required for acceptance into the Educational Specialist program.
- Students have 8 years to complete coursework for degree. Students who have not enrolled for 24 consecutive months must follow the degree and program requirements in the GVSU catalog that are in effect at the time of their re-entry.
- Students must earn a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on GVSU graduate coursework with a letter grade of "C" or higher for all courses used for degree.
- Students must apply for degree online through the Registrar's Office at <http://www.gvsu.edu/registrar>.
- All candidates applying for certification must initiate the certification recommendation process by self-registering in the Michigan Online Educator Certification System (MOECS) at www.michigan.gov/moeecs.
