Program Requirement Notes

- Requirements for the ESL endorsement (K-8 or 6-12 depending on a candidate's teaching certificate) include the completion of courses listed on this planned program and a passing score on the MTTC Test 86, English as a Second Language. To receive the K-12 ESL endorsement, students must complete the full TESOL master's program.

- Students must apply in advance for the practicum course. Advisor approval is required. Apply online at <http://www.gvsu.edu/coe/grad/app>. Application deadlines: May 15 for fall enrollment, September 15 for winter enrollment, and February 15 for spring/summer enrollment.
- All students must complete Responsible Conduct of Research training as a graduation requirement. This online training should be completed prior to completion of 50% of the graduate program or prior to engaging in any research activity. Certification expires after 3 years and must be current while engaged in any research activity. - Practicum requires candidates to work with English Learners in their own or others' settings.

Important Program Policies

- Students must apply and be accepted for graduate study in the College of Education. Students who have not been accepted will not be permitted to enroll in coursework beyond 6 semester hours.
- Students who have not enrolled for 24 consecutive months must follow the degree and program requirements in the GVSU catalog that are in effect at the time of their re-entry.
- This program does not result in a master's degree without completion of additional coursework.
- Students who wish to obtain a master's degree have 8 years to complete coursework for the degree.
- Students must earn a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on GVSU graduate coursework. If pursuing a master's degree, a letter grade of "C" or higher is required for all courses used for degree.
- All candidates applying for certification must initiate the certification recommendation process by self-registering in the Michigan Online Educator Certification System (MOECS) at www.michigan.gov/moeecs.
- Students must hold an active elementary or secondary Michigan teaching certificate at the time of application to add the ESL endorsement to their teaching certificates.
