Program Requirement Notes

1. Requirements for the ESL endorsement (K-8 or 6-12) include the completion of courses listed in the TESOL Core Courses and Practicum sections and a passing score on the MTTC Test 86, English as a Second Language. To receive the K-12 ESL endorsement, students must complete the full TESOL master’s program.

3. Students must apply in advance for each practicum or capstone course. Advisor approval is required. Apply online at <http://www.gvsu.edu/coe/grad/app>. Application deadlines: May 15 for fall enrollment, September 15 for winter enrollment, and February 15 for spring/summer enrollment.
4. Students should meet with their advisor midway through their program to decide on a capstone (EDR 693 or EDR 695) and discuss plans for completion. Subject to department approval, capstone course credits may be taken in variable amounts from 1-3 credits (EDR 693) or 1-6 credits (EDR 695) and require continuous enrollment each semester until completed.
5. All students must complete Responsible Conduct of Research training as a graduation requirement. This online training should be completed prior to completion of 50% of the graduate program or prior to engaging in any research activity. Certification expires after 3 years and must be current while engaged in any research activity. Important Program Policies

- Students must apply and be accepted for graduate study in the College of Education. Students who have not been accepted will not be permitted to enroll in coursework beyond 6 semester hours.
- Students have 8 years to complete coursework for degree. Students who have not enrolled for 24 consecutive months must follow the degree and program requirements in the GVSU catalog that are in effect at the time of their re-entry.
- Students must earn a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher on GVSU graduate coursework with a letter grade of "C" or higher for all courses used for degree.
- Students must apply for degree online through the Registrar’s Office at <http://www.gvsu.edu/registrar>.
- All candidates applying for certification must initiate the certification recommendation process by self-registering in the Michigan Online Educator Certification System (MOECS) at www.michigan.gov/moecs.
