Faculty Updates

Bart Merkle Named Distinguished Professor of Education

The Higher Education program faculty is pleased to welcome Dr. Bart Merkle to the faculty this fall as a Distinguished Professor of Education. As you may know, Bart served as Vice Provost for Student Affairs and Dean of Students at

Grand Valley for the past thirty-two (32) years. Prior to his service as CSAO at GVSU, he served in student affairs leadership roles at Tulane University, Kalamazoo College, and Hope College. Bart was instrumental in working with faculty and staff colleagues to develop the College Student Affairs Leadership (CSAL) program which began in 1995 with an initial cohort of eleven (11) graduate students. Today the program has evolved into the Higher Education graduate program which has two emphasis areas in the M.Ed. degree – College Student Affairs Leadership (CSAL) and Adult and Higher Education (ADHE) with over 450 alumni serving in administrative roles at colleges and universities across the country. Bart participated in the Fulbright Program for Administrators - Germany in 1995 and he received the Outstanding Performance as a Dean Award from NASPA Region IV-East in 1997. Bart's course load for fall includes EDH 658 Critical Issues in Higher Education, EDH 685/686 Practicum/Graduate Field Experience I & II, and ED 693 Master's Project. During the winter he is scheduled to teach EDH 653 Administration of Student Affairs Programs, EDH 685/686 Practicum/Graduate Field Experience I & II, and ED 693 Master's Project. His research interests include design thinking, leadership and supervision, and bias behavior. Please join us in welcoming Bart to the faculty.
