Armstrong shared a summary of various activities meetings attended and history of Affiliate position at GVSU (see AFAC Bb site – December 2016 Chair Report UAS: Discussion and Recommendation for centralized and standard language for ALL syllabi concerning Fire, Disability, Emergencies, etc. Final format is yet to be determined for a link or placement in ALL syllabi. Recommendation is awaiting Provost review. Additional comments by E. Aboufadel: Syllabus of Record (SOR) and Course Syllabi are owned by the University. In contrast, Course details/content is owned by faculty. In terms of sharing Syllabi and course detail/content, it is OK. Provost is collecting ALL SORs for compliance with upcoming accreditation. CLAS – Faculty Development Committee (FDC): Chair was invited to review role of AFAC and Affiliate issues including: support and encouragement of Affiliate voice to be amplify in CLAS; potential areas of conflict between Affiliate and Tenure/Tenure Track (T/TT) faculty; importance of role of teaching; history of Affiliates at GVSU; Ambiguity/difficulty with contract renewal and performance evaluations; issues and support concerning large student course and how this impacts workload; how and when Affiliate lines convert to T/TT lines; issue of salary disparity versus cost effectives between Affiliate and T/TT faculty; and recognition that Tenure/Tenure Track faculty are "heart and soul" of department and that Affiliates "are not trying to takeover." Reception at FDC was supportive for Affiliates by CLAS Affiliates and T/TT faculty.
