**Report from the Chair:**

- 1) The chair thanked all who provided review of the UCC memo to OEC indicating suggestions for the memo to ECS indicating the creation of the OEMC.
- 2) The UCC chair indicated that one course approved in the previous week needed to be returned to improve the Transcript Copy, which was unclear at the time
- 3) The UCC Chair indicated that there will be an increased use of the consent agenda (established about 2011), for CCPs that do not alter anything that may affect curriculum between colleges. When viewing the consent agenda, UCC members are encouraged to look at and, if needed, bring a course off of the consent agenda for discussion in committee.

**Report from the Provost:**

- 1) Provost Cimitile addressed the needs of the adult returning student population and associated opportunities. Examination of market data in MI shows the need for skill sets in data analytics, global communications, project management, and leadership. The proposal being brought forth is to create certificates around these 4 areas for returning adults (12-18 cr). Certificates (for developing a skill set) have not yet been built, but development of all 4 certificates are being done currently. After discussion, Motion was made to support the development of targeted certificates for degree completion using IRIS as a foundation for this initiative, and to support the advertising before complete development. Motion passed.
- 2) A second topic was discussed briefly (for informational review) concerning efforts at Graduate Council to grant credit for work-life experience. This currently is at a discussion phase at Graduate Council and no actions/recommendations had been taken as of this meeting.
