- Acute/Dual Care Track C/A focused students must have a minimum of 1-year full time acute care experience
- Students must declare population focus by Winter 2nd year and elect for C/A dual or single-track focus by first clinical semester
- Dual Care Track C/A focused students need 600-700 clinical hours in Acute Care and 500-600 clinical hours in Primary Care at completion of program (1200 hours; not including simulation hours)

- Program gap analysis to determine program plan
- Enroll in Didactic/Clinical content for population track focus beginning Winter 2nd year
