

# **Drugs 101: What's Important to Know**

Brought to communities includes a mock bedroom with paraphernalia and a presentation discussing trends in adolescent substance use.

In 12 year over 200 programs presented

# Outreach Programs

# Vaping 101: What's Important to Know

Offered in evenings for communities as well as during day directly for students.

Includes: What vaping is, advertising, potentially harmful chemicals, adverse effects of nicotine on teen brain development.

In two years over 150 presentations to over 40,000 students and adults in SE Michigan.

Survey of 25 middle and high school administrators

- 70% have seen LESS vaping among students in their buildings. However, only
- 30% feel vaping use has started to DECREASE among youth in their communities
  - 45% same
  - 25% increasing



100% have done something to educate youth.

- 68% have had science/health teacher address it
- 80% have had an outside speaker come in

10% have installed vape detectors in school, but were unsure of the effectiveness.

Comments from schools without detectors focused on cost and reliability

70% have instituted restorative practices in addition to or in lieu of suspension

 Many utilize youth networks, community coalitions, police departments, and SROs to help with restorative practices.



### Biggest needs:

- Better/more education students And parents
- Addiction counseling/support
- Better legislation/uniform legal consequences



#### Law

- 2016 Federal "Tobacco Control Act"
- Dec 2019 "Federal Tobacco 21"
- Sept 2019 MI Senate Bills 106 and 155.
  - Anyone under 18 years old, cannot purchase, attempt to purchase, possess or attempt to possess or use in a public place a vapor product.
  - Nor use a false "proof of age" for the above.
