## WHO ARE THE WRITING CONSULTANTS?

- A group of 55 undergraduate and graduate Grand Valley students who:
  - Come from a variety of majors, disciplines, and experiences
  - Go through a lengthy application and interview process
  - Receive multiple hours of training, including in a one-credit class taught by the Director of Writing Across The Curriculum
  - Attend professional development seminars in order to further improve their consulting abilities
  - Are excited to talk to you about your writing

## WE CAN HELPYOU:

- On any type of writing, at any stage of the process, including:
  - Understanding your assignment and audience expectations
  - Brainstorming and selecting a topic
  - Organizing ideas and structuring your paper
  - Writing effective introductions and conclusions
  - Revising, editing, and formatting your work
  - Integrating and/or documenting sources




## WRITING CENTER TRUE OR FALSE

  - True. We will work with any and all types of writing.




#### WRITING CENTER TRUE OR FALSE



- A writing consultant will revise my work for me.
  - False. A consultant can assist you with any aspect of your writing, but making changes is always up to the writer. Whether we assist you in a real-time consultation or via email, we want to give you feedback, resources, and strategies so you can improve your own writing.
- Writing Center physical locations are closed due to COVID.
  - ☐ True. The Writing Center offers online support every hour we are open. We want to support you however we can, but (when in doubt) check website for up-to-date information.
- Only bad writers go to the Writing Center.
  - ☐ False! Writers of all levels come to the Writing Center, from beginning writers to graduate students. Good writing requires revision and feedback helps all writers improve their work.

- Use your GVSU login to enter the system, then select any option from the blue navigation bar.











# Making appointments in Book It




Selecting "new appointment" takes you to the Knowledge Market page with descriptions of each service. After selecting your service, you can fill out your desired appointment information.




# Checking-in for virtual appointments

At your scheduled start time, your consultant will set a Google Meet link for your session on this page. As soon as the consultant is ready, you can join them by selecting "enter appointment." Please occasionally **refresh your page** while waiting so you see the option when it becomes available.
