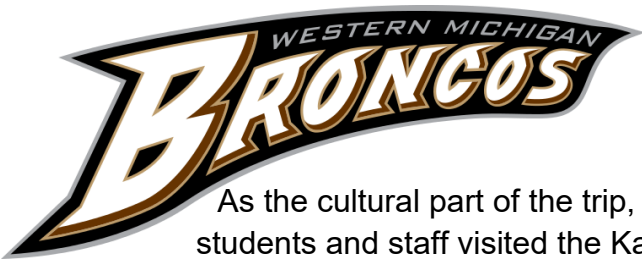
EDUCATIONAL/CULTURAL TRIP RECAP

LaJoya understands education is power. Such as the power to educate those that are under-educated, and she intends on being an active participant in doing so.

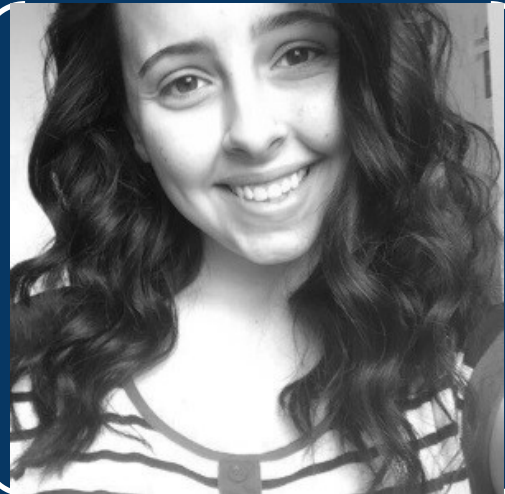
We are lucky to have LaJoya as a part of the TRIO team!
