The FSBC recommends that the Provost change the minimum pay rates for part-time adjuncts as follows:

- 1. Minimum pay levels as follows:
 - a. \$750\$950 per credit hour for part-time adjuncts who have taught for Grand Valley for less than five years.
 - b. \$850\$1050 per credit hour for senior part-time adjuncts.

Rationale

FSBC recommends this change for the following reasons.

- 1. This would make the rate at GVSU more competitive with peer universities and with GRCC (see attached).
- 2. Most adjuncts already receive a rate above the proposed new \$950 minimum (see attached).
- 3. The higher rate will make it easier to attract and retain quality adjuncts; this is especially important for units that are struggling to hire people with the credentials necessary to meet accreditation standards.
