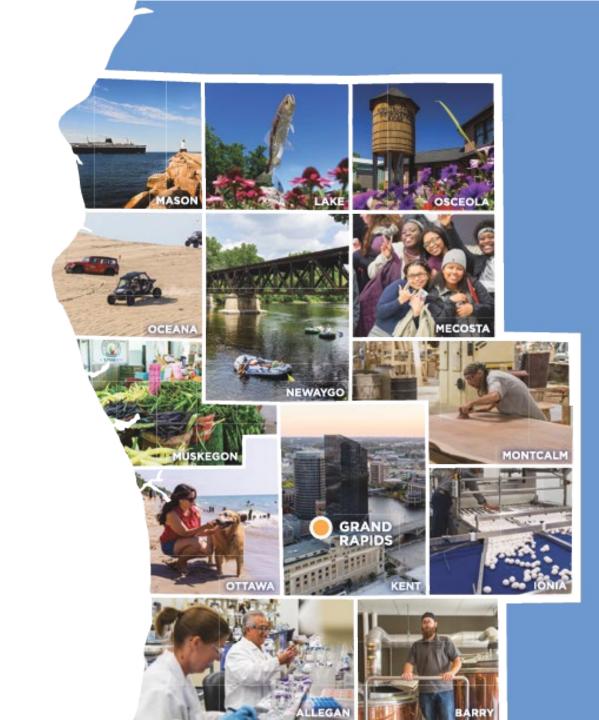

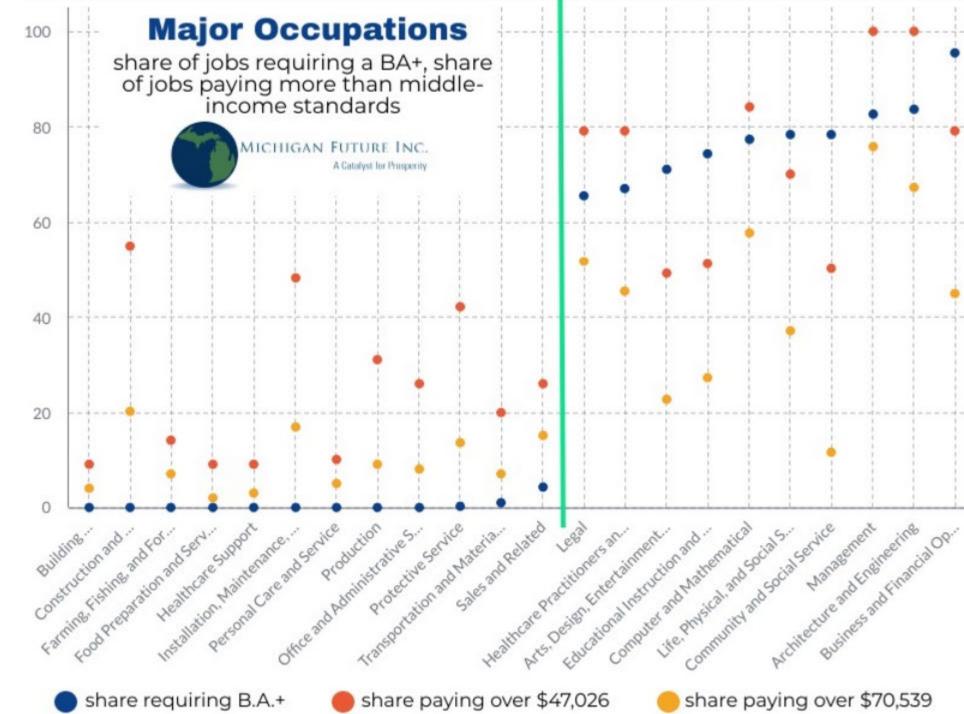
#### Winners and losers of brain drain

- Minnesota (9<sup>th</sup>) and Illinois (5<sup>th</sup>) lead the Midwest
- Half of US states are experiencing brain drain of >20%
- The top 10 states have gains
- The bottom 40 have losses

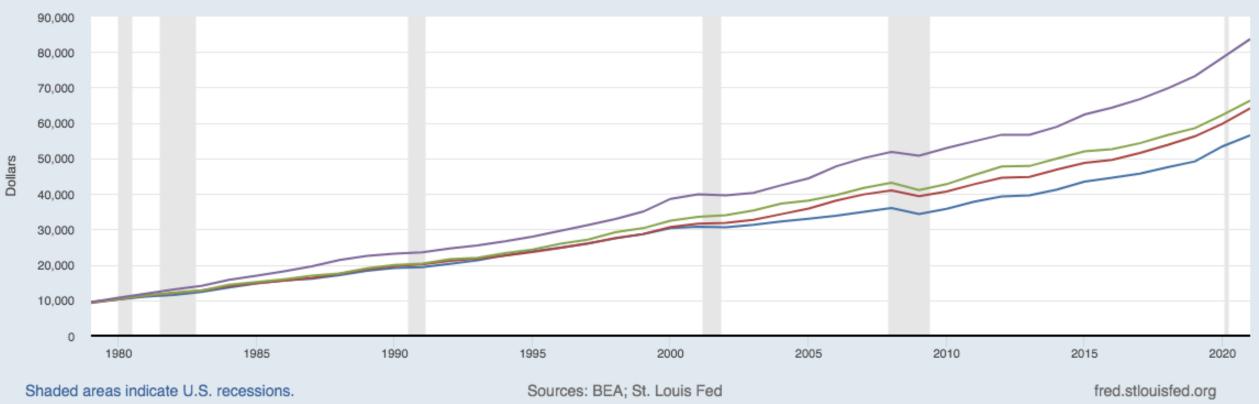
### **INCOME CHANGES OVER TIME**

🛫 — Per Capita Personal Income in Michigan

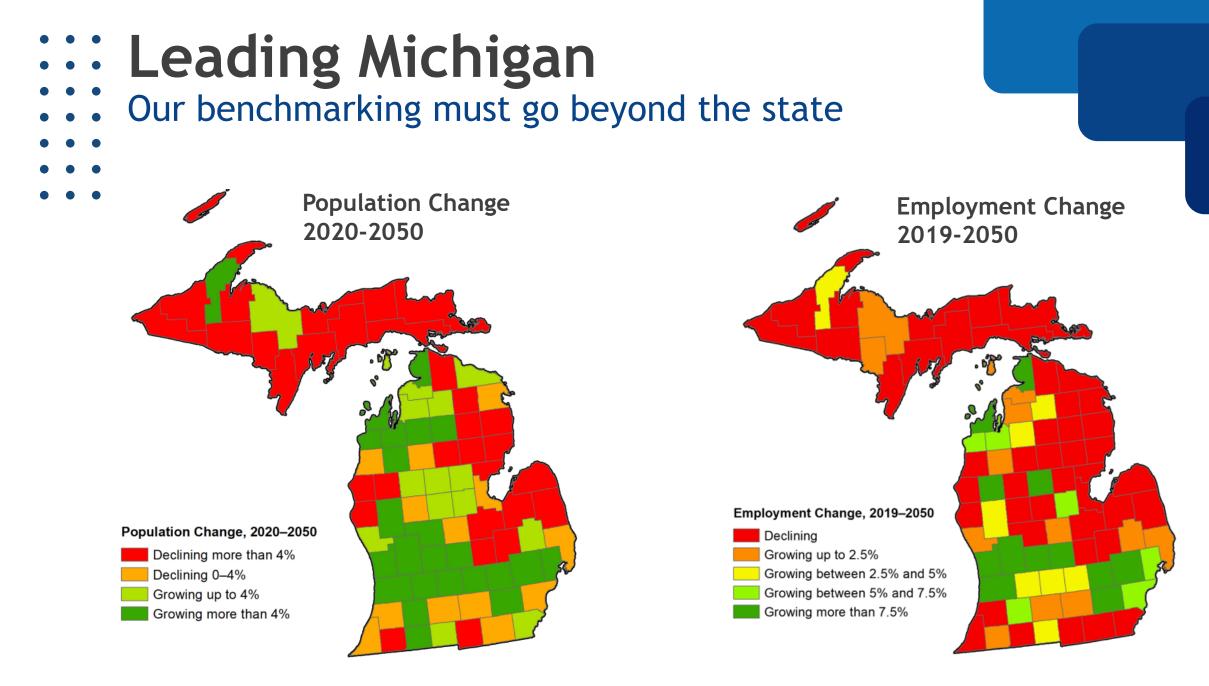

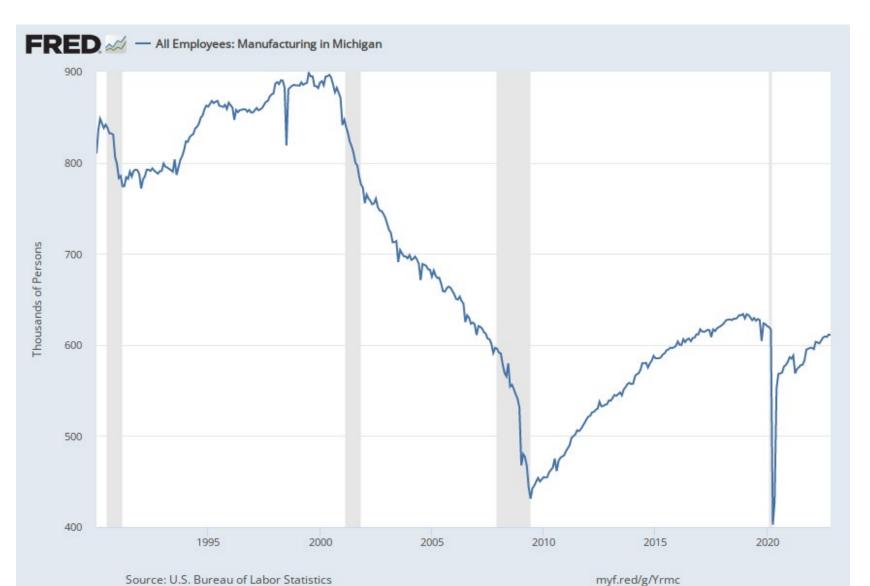


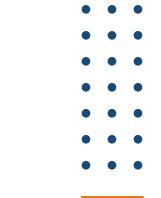
- Manufacturing remains a key component of our economy at 20% of the region's jobs

Manufacturing jobs in Michigan have declined the past 30+ years

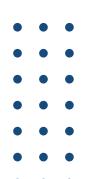

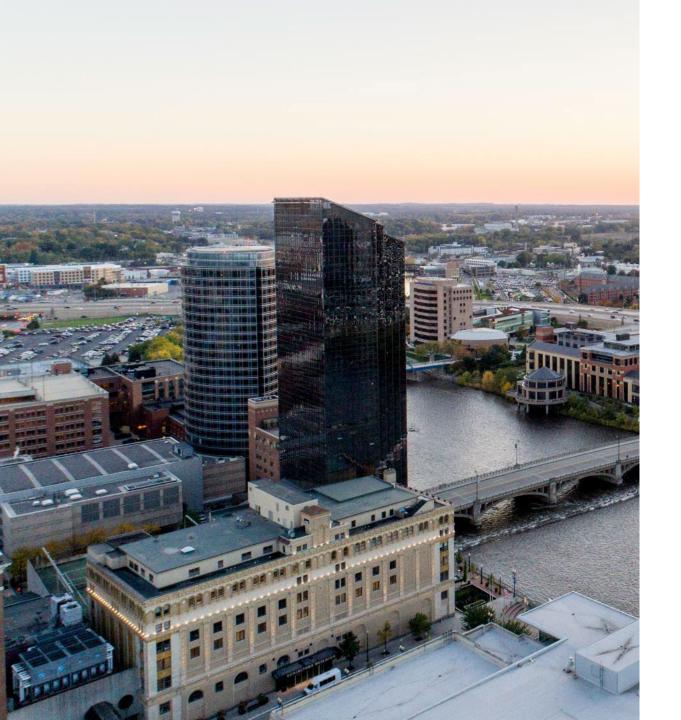
