- One-on-one contact with Minors, unless in public spaces
- Engaging in abusive conduct of any kind
- Engaging in private communication not pertaining to Program matters with a Minor by email, telephone, text message, social media, or any other method at any time, except when there is a clear educational purpose
- Meeting with Minors outside of established times for Program activities
- Engaging in any sexual activity, romantic conversations, or sexually explicit comments
- Possessing fireworks, firearms, knives, or other weapons, unless being used for an approved instructional Program
