Campus Programming

Individual Travel

- Can be used for Travel or Conference Registration.
- Must be domestic travel within the U.S.
- 5 Individuals per organization for a maximum of \$500 per student.
- Cannot fund lodging, souvenirs, or food.
- President/financial officer needs to submit the 5 names to slffin@gvsu.edu

Vehicle Rental

- Able to receive up to twice per academic year with a total cap of \$1,500.
- Must be domestic travel within the U.S.
- Able to request, car, minivan, or passenger vans.
- Cannot request for gas, parking, or tolls.
- All rentals are done through our office.

Organizational Competition

- Can be used only for groups with a group competition fee or organizations with unavoidable annual dues associated with attending an event.
- There is no per person fee/rate.
- Cannot be individual dues, retreats, or recreation activities.

Campus Programming

- The event must be open to the whole student body and must relate to the mission of the RSO.
- Can be requested by all organizations.
- Bring all supporting documents to the Funding Board Meeting, such as catering quotes, room reservations, etc. If necessary documents are not available at the time of the meeting, the request will be tabled.

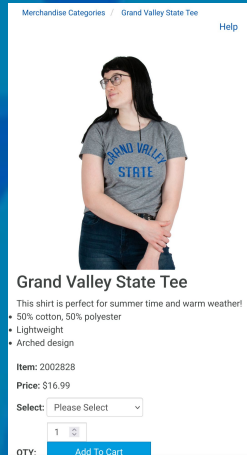





• If your school does not meet one of the three criteria above, but you believe your school has other extenuating circumstances, you may email John Garcia at jjgarcia@harpercollege.edu and make a request to be allowed to compete in the virtual bowl.

Important Information

- All schools must pay a \$130 APPE Intercollegiate Ethics Bowl® program participation fee to APPE to participate in the regional competitions. Most regions have an additional "host fee" to cover their local costs which, this year, is also paid to APPE at the time of registration. Those funds will be distributed to the regions at the close of registration. There is no requirement for APPE membership for regional teams.
- Teams that qualify for the APPE Intercollegiate Ethics Bowl® national competition will pay an additional national competition registration fee to APPE after the regional competitions are completed and the qualifying teams are announced. You cannot register for nationals before receiving a qualifying bid from your regional competition. [Click here for more information about the national competition.](#)
- Your team will not be considered "registered" for any competition until all required forms and fees have been submitted.

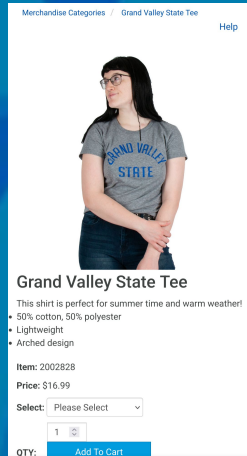





Important Information

- All schools must pay a \$130 APPE Intercollegiate Ethics Bowl® program participation fee to APPE to participate in the regional competitions. Most regions have an additional "host fee" to cover their local costs which, this year, is also paid to APPE at the time of registration. Those funds will be distributed to the regions at the close of registration. There is no requirement for APPE membership for regional teams.
- Teams that qualify for the APPE Intercollegiate Ethics Bowl® national competition will pay an additional national competition registration fee to APPE after the regional competitions are completed and the qualifying teams are announced. You cannot register for nationals before receiving a qualifying bid from your regional competition. [Click here for more information about the national competition.](#)
- Your team will not be considered "registered" for any competition until all required forms and fees have been submitted.
