Annis Water Resources Institute Internships SUMMER 2021

The Robert B. Annis Water Resources Institute is offering up to seven (7) competitive spring/summer semester internships. These internships will be awarded to Grand Valley State University **undergraduate** students in any discipline, as long as it can relate to water in some capacity. The purpose of these internships is to broaden the student's perspective in his or her chosen discipline through practical application. The selected students are required to give a presentation regarding their summer work at an AWRI internal seminar to be held at the end of the internship. **Applicants are requested to complete an Intern Application, submit a resume, and compose a one-page essay addressing the criteria listed below (bulleted items).**

Applicants will be judged using the following criteria:

- ◆ past academic performance with emphasis on improvement
- ◆ an interest in our water resources

These internships are funded by AWRI through various sources and gifts from the Robert B. Annis Foundation.

The recipient of the internship is expected to work up to 40 hours per week on AWRI projects for 14 weeks during the spring/summer semesters 2021 and will be compensated up to \$6,250 in wages, plus \$500 for travel allowance, and \$500 for supplies as part of their research project.
