Position: Adjunct Research Assistant (12 month)

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in a field related to aquatic sciences and/or natural resources management/policy preferred. Selected candidate should have strong organizational skills, experience developing and managing databases, general understanding of natural resource management principles, ability to perform independent research, strong written and oral communication skills, and willingness to work in a collaborative, interdisciplinary setting. Preference will be given to applicants with experience working in aquatic ecosystems. This is a 12-month, grant-funded position, with possibility of extension.

Responsibilities: Responsibilities include day-to-day oversight of study assessing the feasibility of integrated watershed commissions in the State of Michigan. This will involve database preparation and oversight, technical research on drain commissions and watershed districts, scheduling and facilitation of meetings, communication updates to partners, and general administrative duties associated with smooth running of project. In addition, the position may occasionally involve assistance with other projects.
