The National Science Foundation (NSF) has updated its Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) requirements for any new proposal submitted or due on or after **July 31, 2023**. All principal investigators, co-principal investigators, and senior personnel who are or will be supported by NSF funds are required to complete RCR training. 
Seidman Undergraduate Research Assistant (S-URA) Program
